It became known here yesterday that Governor Pierce will bring quo warranto proceedings, if necessary, in order to oust Dr. Thomas Ross from the state fish commission.

This became known upon receipt of information that F. P. Kendall, chairman of the commission, had refused to recognize John C. Veatch, whom Pierce appointed in Ross' place. The governor's proceedings, if they are filed, will set forth that the removal of Ross was legal in all respects, while W. W. Barnes and John Kaste, attorneys for Ross, will claim that there was no vacancy for Veatch to fill at the time of his appointment, inasmuch as he was appointed Saturday while the letter finally ousting Ross was not received by Ross until Monday.
