REOPEN PROBE OF NAVAL OIL LEASES

Washington, Jan. 30.—The special grand jury which will take testimony in the new proceedings here in the case of Senator Burton K. Wheeler of Montana unexpectedly was called upon today to reopen consideration of the naval oil leases.

Atlee Pomerene and Owen J. Roberts, government oil counsel, appeared before the jury when it convened at Judge C. Smith and A. S. Booth officials of the First National bank of Pueblo, Colo., were examined. No indication of the testimony expected was given.

A similar inquiry was held before a grand jury here last summer, but no report was returned.

What fate will befall the measure after it has been passed by both houses and has felt the edge of the executive's axe, remains to be seen, but friends of the bill this morning expressed confidence that they will be able to muster the two thirds needed to override the veto. In the house there is little cause to doubt that their optimism is well founded, but in the senate it is another matter. Their claims in the upper house to the favorable vote of 20 members are seriously disputed by the opposition, which claims 11 votes.

Action on the bill is being closely watched, for it gives promise of testing the strength of the governor in the senate and should the roll call reveal him in control of 11 votes the result will practically mean a deadlock that will defeat all major legislation during the session, for if defeated on this measure the anti-governor forces have sufficient strength in the senate to prevent the enactment of whatever bills they may see fit.
