## VAN WINKLE SAYS BAKER NOT REPRESENTATIVE

Attorney General Van Winkle today sent a letter to Senator S. M. Garland, chairman of the state prohibition department investigation committee, denying that Elisha A. Baker, president of the Oregon Anti-Saloon league and attorney for that organization, represented Van Winkle's office when he advised George L. Cleaver in the affair growing out of Cleaver's raid of the British ship, London Merchant.

In his testimony before the committee Cleaver stated that Baker as an assistant attorney general wrote the apology that Cleaver signed after the raid. Mr. Van Winkle says:

"I read in the press of yesterday that Mr. Cleaver, state prohibition commissioner, testified before your committee that in connection with his search of the British steamship 'London Merchant' and his arrest by the federal authorities therefor, he was advised and represented by Mr. Elisha A. Baker, president and attorney of the Anti-Saloon league, and who he stated, represented the attorney general.

"The last portion of that statement to the effect that Mr. Baker represented the attorney general in that proceeding is untrue. Neither Mr. Baker nor any one else represented me in that matter.

"Mr. Cleaver called me on the telephone and asked if I could represent him, and I informed him, on the account of the nature of the proceeding I could not. He asked if he would be justified in securing other counsel and I informed him that he was at liberty to do so. He then asked if it would be all right to secure the services of Mr. Baker. I told him so far as I was concerned it would, but that he would represent him and not me. No one is authorized to represent the attorney general's office except when such authority is evidenced in writing.

"I will be glad to take oath upon the foregoing statement if it is desired, and in any event it is made under my official oath of office."

## REFORESTATION BILL APPROVED

The state board of forestry met here yesterday and endorsed a reforestation measure that will be introduced at the present session of the legislature. It will provide for the classification of cut-over lands to show what lands are more suitable for timber production than for other purposes. The classification will be according to their value and then the lands would be assessed according to that value and the ratio prevailing in the respective counties.

The board adopted a resolution providing for a committee of three to be appointed by the governor to investigate taxation conditions of timber lands, both cut-over and those growing virgin timber, with the cooperation of the department of the interior and private agencies under the Clarke-McVay act.
