

# HOUSE PASSES MANY BILLS OF ITS OWN

In two hours of steady grinding yesterday the house passed a long list of its own bills. Little debate marked the measure, the members taking the recommendations of the various committees on most of the bills.

House bill 188 would provide that the county treasurer shall send a statement to the school clerks of third class districts notifying them of funds on deposit of their respective district.

House bill 200, by Representatives Oakes and Senator Davis, authorizing district irrigation boards of directors to enter into contract with the federal government for the construction of works, delivery and distribution of waters, passed. The measure, if it becomes a law, will apply particularly to the Baker, Vale and Owyhee projects, according to Oakes. It will also make it possible for other districts in the future to take advantage of government co-operation.

Use of vegetable fats in the manufacture of condensed milk would be prohibited under house bill 361, passed.

Killing and trapping of beavers in counties east of the Cascade mountains and in most of those in western Oregon would be prevented under house bill 337 passed. In certain sections of Douglas county killing would be permitted, also in Clatsop and Columbia counties. The exceptions are made in these sections where the animals destroy dikes. Property owners or renters would be permitted to trap or kill the animals whenever they damaged property.

House bill 221, passed, would prevent any member of a school board of clerk from writing insurance on school property. Representative Graham attacked the bill, pointing out that it would rule out some of the best directors available. The bill would also exclude any financial dealings of any other person with a school

district if he were a member of the board.

House bill 40, providing for penalties against persons changing the course of a stream in a drainage district, passed.

The Coquille river will be closed to sailing if house bill 114, passed by the house yesterday morning becomes a law. Representative King of Coos county introduced the measure, explaining that passage of the bill was desired by most of the people in Coos county. It will serve to increase the fish supply and keep the channel in better condition, according to King.

The county school superintendent, county judge and assessor would constitute the boundary board in matters pertaining to school districts, under house bill 112, passed. Roberts of Wasco county introduced the measure.

House bill 162, authorizing the governor to sign on behalf of the state petitions for drainage, passed. It would also legalize any action of the governor taken along this line heretofore.

A herd inspector for Josephine county would be created under

house bill 186, passed.

Railroads would be permitted to file on and acquire water from streams, springs and other bodies of water of the state for operating purposes under house bill 162, which brought up extensive discussion when it came up for third reading. It was re-referred to the committee on the revision of laws.
