

MILL CITY TO STAGE PROGRAM FOR WASHINGTON

Mill City, Or., Feb. 20.—Washington's birthday will be observed quite elaborately this year at the Mill City high school with a program to be given at the school Monday afternoon, including the putting on of several plays by the high school pupils and a drama by the primary grade pupils. Parents of the pupils will be invited to attend.

AMERICA LAW CRAZY SAYS TOM MARSHALL

Saginaw, Mich., Feb. 20.—The United States is "law crazy," said Thomas R. Marshall, former vice-president in an address here last night. "Documents are not the foundation of the government of this nation," said Mr. Marshall. "It is the conscience of the American people that lies behind everything that is done or attempted. We cannot legislate a change in men's hearts. Reformers cannot attain their purposes by passing more laws. It is the will to accomplish anything that finally results in its fruition."

EVIDENCE AGAINST STOKES BARRED BY COURT RULE

Chicago, Feb. 20.—(By Associated Press.)—Judge W. N. Gemmill today upheld objections of counsel for W. E. Stokes, charged with conspiracy to defame Mrs. Helen Helen Elwood Stokes, to the admission of testimony based on affidavits and correspondence of Stokes' agents. Though an hour's conference was held in chambers on a demand of the state that the defense produce affidavits and correspondence in his possession, the defense did not produce them after the court issued his decision in a whisper audible only to counsel.

WARREN HASTINGS DEAD

Dallas, Or., Feb. 20.—Funeral services for Warren Hastings, aged 59 years, who died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. E. C. Day, on February 15, were held Tuesday, February 17, at the Chapman & Henkle chapel. Rev. W. S. Gordon of the Methodist church officiated. Mr. Hastings was a veteran of the Civil war. He enlisted in troop M of the Fourth regiment of cavalry on December 21, 1855 and served until December 29, 1854. He was born in Lafayette county, Wisconsin, December 12, 1855. He was married in March, 1885, to Katherine Twells, who died many years ago. He is survived by three children, Mrs. E. C. Day, with whom he had lived the past four years; Mrs. Minnie Horback of San Diego, Cal., and Samuel Hastings of San Francisco, Cal.

REFORESTRATION STUDY PROVIDED FOR IN MEASURE

Study of the problem of reforestation by a special committee instructed to prepare a bill for submission at the next legislature would be authorized in house joint resolution No. 29, introduced yesterday afternoon by Representatives Carkins and Reynolds. The resolution points out that the bill defeated at the present session had not had enough publicity and that members of the legislature were inadequately informed on the problem of reforestation.

The commission would be composed of three persons to be chosen by the speaker of the house and two by the president of the senate. The resolution would give the president and speaker authority to choose members or non-

NEW BUILDING BILL IS KILLED

The commission would be called upon to organize within 30 days after appointment of its members. Within one year completion of a bill would be required and the same ordered given to the press. Thereupon, one or more public hearings would be held prior to the next session of the legislature when the proposed reforestation code would be presented.

No compensation would be provided for the commission's members. Traveling expenses, however, would be paid. Appropriation of \$100 would be called for to cover expenses of the commission.
