

INCOME RETURNS TO BE RECEIVED UNTIL MARCH 16

Portland, Mar. 10—In view of the fact that March 15, the final day for filing income tax returns, falls on Sunday, Clyde G. Huntley, collector of internal revenue, announced today that under instructions from the internal revenue bureau these returns would be received at his office on Monday, March 16, until midnight. Out-of-town taxpayers must see that their returns are mailed not later than March 16 in order to escape penalties for delinquency.

In order better to take care of the last minute rush, Collector Huntley's office in the custom house in this city will remain open until 9 p. m. Friday and Saturday, March 13 and 14.

Collector Huntley also issued a statement calling the attention of taxpayers to the fact that requests for extension of time for filing returns cannot be approved or granted by his office. All such requests must be sent to the commissioner of internal revenue, Washington, D. C., prior to March 15, and failure to obtain approval will constitute delinquency in making return.

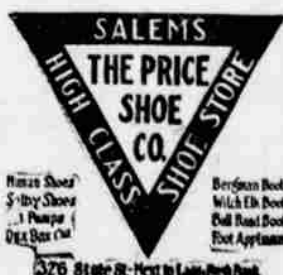
