

MRS. STRAHORN, WIFE OF RAILWAY BUILDER, IS DEAD

San Francisco, Cal., March 16.—Mrs. Robert E. Strahorn of Spokane, wife of a pioneer railroad builder of the Pacific northwest, died yesterday at a hotel here.

Mrs. H. E. Lacey, Los Angeles, a sister of Mrs. Strahorn, and Mrs. Quintro Johnson of Spokane, a niece, were with Mrs. Strahorn when she died.

Strahorn said he expected to arrange for the shipment of Mrs. Strahorn's body to Spokane by Tuesday.

Mrs. Strahorn was conscious up to within a few minutes of her death.

Spokane, Wash., March 16.—Mrs. Carrie Adell Strahorn, who died in San Francisco yesterday, was the author of numerous magazine articles and one book descriptive of her experiences during nearly half a century of travel over the west as the companion of her husband, Robert E. Strahorn, railroad builder.

Since their marriage in 1877, Mrs. Strahorn had accompanied her husband in his work as an engineer, traveling by stage or horseback. She was declared to have been the first white woman to explore completely and describe Yellowstone park and what are now Glacier and Rocky Mountain national parks. She also was one of the first women to explore and detail the wonders of Alaska.

ASKS REMOVAL OF EXECUTRIX

Asking that Willetta Mott be removed as executrix of the estate of Dr. W. S. Mott, and a competent person be named in her stead, N. H. Stonebrink has filed a petition in probate.

He declares that prior to his death Dr. Mott signed a note for \$500 with Stonebrink in order to pay his taxes. Part of the note was repaid by services but the balance, with interest, is still due, he alleges.

He states he has made frequent demands on the executrix for the payment of the note. He states she has always referred him to her attorney, James Mott of Astoria, who, Stonebrink states, has ignored his importunities.

Stonebrink states that the appraisement of the estate showed assets of \$28,900 in real property and \$1018 in personal property with incumbrances of \$18,042. He states the executrix, according to report, sold property belonging to the estate for \$74,000 and there is plenty of property exempt from execution to pay the note.

JAPANESE PASS ALIEN LAW

Salem High Takes Championship By Downing Franklin

The statements "we'll beat Salem all right," which Franklin high school rooters greeted the world at the close of Franklin's win over Eugene, Saturday afternoon, proved to be somewhat of a premature estimate. The local team dominated thoroughly, completely and convincingly that the Portland aggregation was only second best, and a rather poor second best at that.

Now that it is all over people do not mind admitting that they really expected Franklin to win. It is a known fact that bets had even been made that Franklin would make twice as many scores as Salem. As it turned out Salem made nearly twice as many as Franklin.

Franklin Was Favorite
 Franklin took a one point lead at the start of the game when Epps converted a free throw, but John Drager soon evened the count with a score by the same route, and Ellis shortly after dropped in a field goal. The first quarter ended 3 to 1.

In the second quarter Drager pulled down a field goal, putting his team still farther into the lead, but late in the period Scallon dropped in two in succession, bringing the count to five all. A basket by Heenan a few minutes before the gun sounded brought Salem into a two-point lead at the end of the period.

In the third quarter the Salemites managed to keep their lead, even adding to it a little, the

fourth quarter beginning with 13 to 9, Salem, marked on the scoreboard. If Franklin had been able to stage one of its sensational rallies, the kind that saved the day against Pendleton and Eugene, the story might have been different. The Portlanders did try to rally, but with little effect. What rallying was done was done mostly by Salem. Toward the close of the game the Salem players took the ball well back under the Franklin basket. The Portlanders, thinking that Salem was stalling for time, allowed themselves to be teased away from the Salem goal. Once the Franklin men were down where the ball was, Salem broke for its own basket, so Franklin players being left to guard it. Twice the trick was worked for a basket by the Salem team.

Trophy Is Presented.
 The championship trophy, shaped like a basketball and made of silver, was presented in behalf of Willamette university to the Salem team at the close of the game. Ashby, acting as captain of the team, took the trophy and was carried from the floor on the shoulders of Salem rooters. Old timers at the tournament recall that in 1921 a Franklin team took the championship from a Salem team of which the present Ashby's brother was captain. Nothing like coming back and maintaining the family honor, they say.

Saturday night's win is the second time in history that a Salem team has won a state championship during the six years the state tournament has been held. In 1920, the first year a state meet was held, the local team eliminated Lincoln in the finals by a one-point margin. Salem now has one more tournament title to its credit than any other school in the state, no other team having won the meet more than once.

In the semi-final Saturday afternoon Salem had little difficulty in winning from McMinnville, Eugene's defeat at the hands of Franklin came hard. Eugene taking the lead early in the game and keeping it most of the time of playing. The score at half time stood 10 to 4 in favor of Eugene.

By virtue of winning the Oregon state title the Salem team becomes qualified to enter the lists in the interstate meet to be held in Salem next week. Other entries will be Rupert high of Idaho and Yakima high of Washington, these two having won the titles of their own states in tournaments closing at Boise and Seattle, Saturday night. A California team may or may not be entered in the interstate met. Present indications that California has no definite, undisputed state champion. The possibility is seen, however, that some representative team may be invited to the tourney.
