

# VICTIMS TELL OF PRANKS PLAYED BY BIG TORNADO

West Frankfort, Ill., March 20.—(By Associated Press.)—Many wind freaks were reported in Wednesday's tornado. Murphysboro tax receipts of Wednesday's date were picked up at Fairfield, 50 miles northeast.

A barber chair found in a field near here was a mystery as no barber shop was known to have been in the stricken West Frankfort area. Presumably the chair had been transported through the air from some other town.

A frame building of the West Frankfort water plant was left standing untouched while large trees on all sides were snapped off or torn up by the roots.

Hundreds of automobiles here had their tops blown off, were hurled upside down, or virtually demolished.

Most of a tin can dump was picked up from one side of the West Frankfort-Lentons highway and transferred to the other side.

A grove of trees near here reminded observers of the family wash day because of the articles of clothing stretched on the limbs.

DeSoto, Ill., March 20.—Jesse Pankey of Harco, who was returning to his home from St. Louis with his wife and two small children in an automobile when Wednesday's tornado approached, today related his attempt to seek shelter and described a fantasy of the winds.

He swung into a garage to escape, Pankey said, and as he stepped from the automobile, the roof of the garage was whirled away. Next, he asserted, his car was tossed into the air and carried off with his wife and children in it.

He also was lifted and blown five blocks, alighting unharmed on the Illinois Central railroad tracks.

His wife and children later were found in a ploughed field and were only slightly injured. He added that the last time he saw his automobile it was still sailing through the clouds.
