

SILVERTON TO BE HOST TO DOUBLE CHURCH SESSION

Silverton, Or., March 24.—(Special.)—A program of more than usual interest will be given at St. John's church Tuesday evening, March 24. The Oregon district of the women's missionary federation is holding its annual meeting at Silverton on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday of this week and the Tuesday night program is given under the auspices of the federation. A great number of visiting ministers and members of the federation will be at Silverton during the week as the Lutheran circuit of ministers is also meeting at Silverton simultaneously with the federation. Mrs. M. G. Gundersen of Silverton is president of the Oregon district of the federation and will preside during the meetings. Mrs. M. A. Christensen of Portland, who is president of the Pacific district of the federation will also be present and address the audience.

The program Tuesday night will be open to the public and contains the following numbers: Invocation by Rev. I. N. Stuhjeger of Glendale, Or.; address of welcome, Mrs. M. G. Gundersen; response by a visiting minister; vocal solo, "Open the Gates of the Temple," Mrs. M. G. Gundersen, with a violin obligato by Alfred Jensen and piano accompaniment by Mrs. Olaf Solum. The main topic for the evening will then be taken up for discussion. This is "Christian Nurture" and will be given by means of three papers. Mrs. H. Rowen of Monitor will give the first paper which is on "Childhood." This will be followed by a song given by a group of little children. The second paper is "Youth," given by Mrs. Gordon McCall of Silverton. Following this a sextet composed of Ingelborg Goplerud, Cora Sater, Esther Towse, Esther Larson, Mamie Holman and Myrna Sather, will sing a selection. The third paper is "Home, Our Ideal." This paper has been prepared by Rev. M. A. Christensen, formerly of Portland but now of Philadelphia. Mrs. George Henriksen of Silverton will read it. Mrs. M. A. Christensen will give a few remarks and the program will close with benediction of Rev. H. A. L. Hjermstad of Chinook, Wash.

BATTLE FLEET OFF TO PRACTICE

Naval Base, San Pedro, Cal., Mar. 24.—Dawn Monday saw the combined United States fleet preparing to put to sea for two days for practice runs preliminary to the climax of the year's gunnery program—force practice scheduled to be held next Wednesday about 70 miles from this port.

Force practice involves a test of the effectiveness of the full gunnery powers of the main battle line of the navy and comes closer to the actual reality of a great battle than any peace time practice undertaken by the fleet.

The signal "commence firing" went out by the flagship after the "enemy" string of sea and air targets has been located by scouting forces and the dreadnaughts have defended themselves against torpedo attack by destroyer squadrons, will unleash a cataclysmic hail of steel projectiles fired simultaneously from some twenty-four 16 inch guns, seventy 12 inch guns, twenty 10 inch guns and other smaller sea weapons. Tons upon tons of metal will be hurled more than ten miles at the targets within the space of a few minutes. The fleet's swift steel knockout punch will be demonstrated on a canvas adversary.

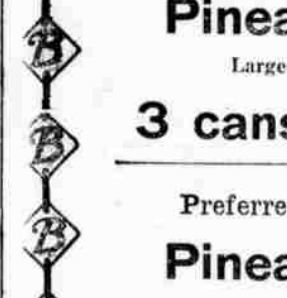
