

### \$4,000,000 FROM HIGHWAY FUNDS PAID COUNTIES

Secretary of State Kozar yesterday completed distribution to the counties of the state and to the state highway fund a total of \$3,281,277.59, representing receipts from motor vehicle licenses for 1925 up to March 15. Of this amount one-fourth, or \$820,694.48, goes to the counties, and three-fourths, or \$2,460,583.11, to the highway fund. The total of \$3,281,277.59 are the net receipts after deducting refunds of \$2890.93 and estimated administrative expenses of \$143,821.87.

The net distributed yesterday was the largest ever distributed from that source by over \$400,000. The amount distributed March 15 last year was \$3,574,229.41. On September 15 a division will be made from the receipts up to that time.

Collection of the 1925 license moneys began September 15 last. Besides the totals given above the following totals are shown on Kozar's statement: Total cash turned over to treasurer, \$4,125,100.09; refunds on account of duplications, etc., \$2890.93; gross receipts, \$4,125,209.46; administrative expense, \$143,931.87.

The figures for Marion and Polk counties are:

Marion—Total cash turned over to treasurer, \$269,303.86; refunds \$207.75; gross receipts, \$269,096.11; administrative expense, \$3882.46; net receipts, \$259,713.65; county's one-fourth share, \$64,928.41; highway fund's three-fourths share, \$194,785.24.

Polk—Total turned over to treasurer, \$64,994.64; refunds, \$26.75; gross receipts, \$64,967.89; administrative expense, \$2265.20; net receipts, \$62,702.69; county's one-fourth share, \$15,675.67; highway fund's three-fourths share, \$47,027.02.

### BLAST WRECK SCHOOL; BOMB IS THOUGHT CAUSE

Pittsburgh, Pa., Mar. 27—An explosion early today wrecked the public school building at Swanton, a suburb of Jacobus, the janitor, was reported missing and police and firemen are searching the ruins in the belief that he met death in the blast. Officers believe the explosion was not accidental and a reward of \$1000 was offered by Fire Marshal Thomas Pfarr for information leading to the arrest of those responsible.

The blast rocked houses and broke windows within a radius of several blocks. One corner of the two-story brick building was wrecked and the remaining walls and roof were cracked and left swaying under the weight of unsupported rafters. A one-story annex was blown to splinters.

A fire alarm was turned in but firemen were unable to find any trace of fire, leading to the belief held by some fire and police officials that the building had been bombed. Fire Marshal Pfarr declared there was no fire under the boilers and no trace of escaping gas. Fire Chief Joseph Morgan of Swanton, declared, however, he believed gas was the probable cause of the blast.
