STAYTON PLANT BID IN BY BANK
The First State & Savings bank of Stayton has bought the property of the Brown-Petzel Lumber company at Stayton to satisfy judgment secured against the lumber company by the bank. The judgment was for \$17,000, but with receiver's expenses, attorney's fees, interest and other costs, the entire judgment, including costs, amounted to \$19,055.55. The real property was bid in for \$18,523.55 and the personal property for \$555. Receiver's costs were \$1097, attorney's fees \$759 and interest and incidentals made up the other in excess of the \$17,000 judgment.
The company is still in bankruptcy proceedings, other property at Stayton being involved.

SAXOPHONES THREATENS LAURELS OF BAGPIPE
Glasgow, March 27.—The saxophone has threatened the laurels of the bagpipe. Since an American jazz opera appeared in Glasgow prior to opening in London, musical Glasgow has been humming and whistling all the variety tunes with all the saxophone variations.
