INDIAN HELD FOR PART IN 2 MURDERS

The living child and sent them both to their eternal resting place "upon coercion of Mormon Joe" as a coroner's jury yesterday charged. The bodies were exhumed on the reservation where they were buried last week. The verdict of the inquest was that the infant died of typhoid fever and that the other child died of cholera.

Both Mormon Joe and Pete Nay are in jail here under guard of the sheriff.

Late yesterday Chavez chided the medicine man with remarks about death of the Indian child and told him that he, too, soon would die for the crime.

While the Mexican, an alleged bootlegger, sat reading in his cell the infuriated Indian secured a leg from the table and crushed his tormentor's skull with it. Two other prisoners interfered but Chavez was morned. Joe and Pete Nay will be taken before the state grand jury at Durango on charges of murder and probably be held for action by the federal grand jury at Durango next Tuesday.
