

CAMP JACKSON CHOSEN AS NAME OF GUARD CAMP

The name of Camp Jackson has been given the tract of 79 acres on the outskirts of Medford where the Oregon national guard will hold its annual encampment this summer. It is named for the county in which it is located and also for Col. James Jackson, medal of honor veteran of the Civil War and an officer of the Oregon national guard for more than 25 years.

About 2300 soldiers will be encamped on the grounds. During the later part of the training period field maneuvers will be featured, infantry, field artillery and engineers participating. This will be preceded by a general review, for which the reviewing party will be Governor Pierce, General Hunter Liggett and General Mesobor. Recreational features for the troops will be provided by the Medford chamber of commerce. The entire command will be taken to Crater Lake, leaving Medford for the lake Saturday, June 29, camp at Union creek, and then going on to the lake and returning to Medford on Sunday.

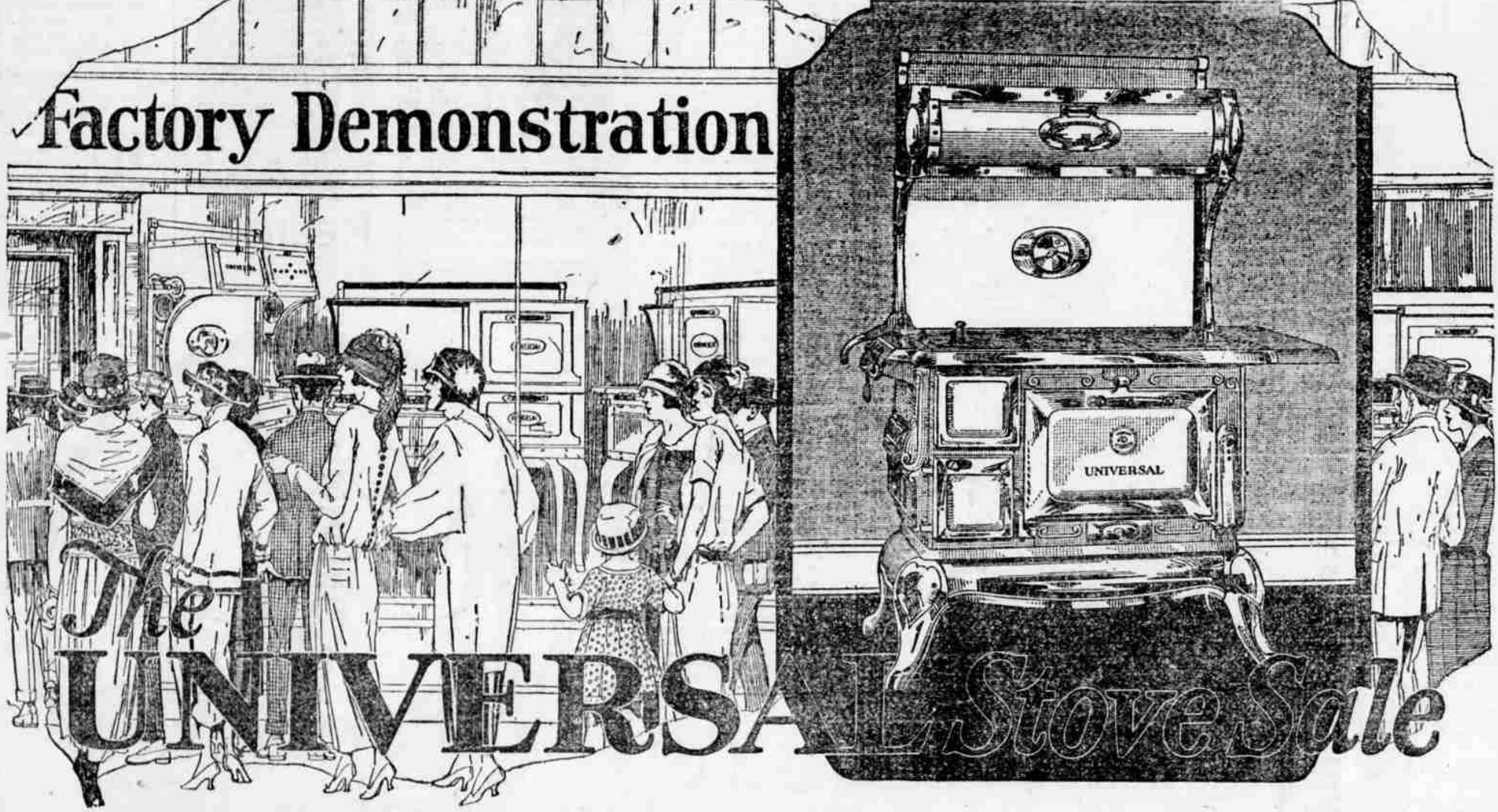
