

### SEEK TO UNITE POLK DISTRICTS ON ROAD PLANS

Dallas, Or., April 10.—It is expected that practically every community organization in Polk county will be represented at a meeting to be held in the circuit court room in Dallas at 7:30 o'clock Wednesday night, April 15, when the organization of a permanent county committee will be attempted, according to W. W. Harcombe, president of the Dallas chamber of commerce.

Through such a permanent committee it is hoped to decide upon a unified county road program and other projects in which all sections will work together, rather than at variance as frequently is the case at present.

The purposes of this meeting has been placed before practically all of the county organizations by speakers of the Dallas chamber or by letter, and it has been received with favor.

Ex-Commissioner Harlow of Lane county will be present to tell of the organization of a county committee there. It is suggested that if an organization can be effected that it adopt by-laws, elect officers and directors and appoint committees to handle questions of roads, agriculture, commerce, animal husbandry, public welfare and other interests as they may develop.

The road committee, which will handle matters of widest concern will probably arrange to confer with Roadmaster Culver of Marion county and other authorities on county road systems. It will also work with the Polk county court in an effort to develop a road building program for the county.

### PRUNE GROWERS ARE TO MEET AT DALLAS

Dallas, Or., April 10.—The annual meeting of the Polk County Co-operative Prune Growers has been called for Monday at 1:30 p. m. at Woodman hall, according to announcement today by Henry Voth, chairman of the board of directors and manager of the local plant. The growers will elect a new board of directors and take up other business of the association.

The general meeting of the affiliated growers units of the prune exchange will be held in Portland on Monday, April 19.

The present outlook of the prune market and reports from the sales agency are encouraging to members of the growers' pool.

**PROPERTY CHANGES HANDS**  
Dallas, Or., April 10.—Two real estate deals, one involving property valued at approximately \$25,000, were completed in Dallas this week.

The largest deal was a trade in which S. F. Southard, veteran flax grower of Polk county, disposed of his 160-acre farm southeast of Dallas to W. J. Turnago of Crabtree, Or. He secured in exchange a new concrete store building and a stock of merchandise valued at \$18,500. The retention stand on the farm was \$16,650.

In the other deal E. U. Shadle traded his residence and two lots in Dallas for the prune orchard and farm of Albert Ewert, south of Dallas. The amount involved in this deal was not announced.
