

HOME OF KLUXER, HELD FOR ATTACK ON GIRL, BURNED

Indianapolis, Ind., April 17.—The large home in Irvington, a suburb, of D. C. Stephenson, banished grand dragon of the Ku Klux Klan of Indiana, indicted for an alleged attack on Miss Madge Oberholtzer, who died Tuesday from effects of poison self-administered followed the alleged attacks, was partially destroyed by fire early today, believed to have been of incendiary origin.

Two cans of kerosene and one of gasoline were found in the wrecked house by firemen. The entire interior and roof of the house was destroyed. Firemen who had the flames under control declared that all gas jets in the building were turned on. An explosion which broke all the windows was heard just before the flames were seen by neighbors.

A short time before the explosion automobiles were seen in the yard by neighbors, who attached no significance to this incident until after the explosion. Police and fire officials are making an investigation.

Stephenson has been living at a downtown hotel for several weeks, and no one was believed to be living in the house.

Miss Madge Oberholtzer, whom Stephenson is charged with assault with intent to kill, assault with attempt to rape, malicious mayhem and with conspiracy to kidnap, was buried yesterday.

BIG FREIGHTERS CRASH AT MOUTH OF COLUMBIA

Astoria, Or., April 17.—The Japanese steamer Yoshida Maru No. 1 and the steamer Charles R. McCormick collided head-on early this morning in the Columbia river off the Port Adams lifesaving station. Both vessels were damaged. One fireman on the Japanese vessel was injured.

The Charles R. McCormick, which proceeded on upstream to the Astoria anchorage, was reported as taking water in a forward hold.

The Yoshida Maru No. 1 absorbed the shock in the destruction of its forepeak tank and was not tak-

ing water in any of its freight holds. The Japanese freighter was en route from Portland with a full cargo of lumber for Shanghai. The Charles R. McCormick was en route upstream to Portland with general freight from Atlantic coast ports. Confused signals were blamed for the smash.
