

### SALE OF POWER RIGHTS IS BACK OF COMPROMISE

A possible deal whereby the Deschutes Falls Power company and the Columbia Deschutes Power company would dispose of their power rights at Shearer's bridge on the Deschutes river is believed to be the big consideration back of the stipulation recently entered into between the power companies and the irrigators on the upper Deschutes river. The company desiring to purchase the power site is believed to be the Portland Electric Power company.

The Deschutes falls Power company and the Columbia Deschutes Power company are both controlled by the Eastern Oregon Land company, which is a property of the Martins, capitalists of San Francisco.

In making such a deal, the transaction would be facilitated if the selling companies were able to show a perpetual right to the water power at Shearer's Bridge. So the main question at issue, and to be decided by the state engineer, is whether the two companies have qualified to hold an appropriation of water rights made prior to 1909, or about 1906. Prior to 1909 the law provided that if the holder of a right showed due diligence in developing the proposed project the right would be perpetual. In 1909 the law was changed limiting water power franchises to 40 years. A prospective purchaser would hesitate to take over a franchise that would be limited to 40 years. Although the companies now holding the franchise have developed no project in the approximate 19 years that they have held the right, it is presumed they will attempt to show that this failure has been justified by reason of unavoidable obstacles.

### INDIANS TO PLAY SHS TOMORROW

Chemawa, April 21—Tomorrow afternoon the Chemawa Indians will clash with the Salem high school on the Chemawa grounds. They have Dandro George who is filling Norwest's position to a tee. He was at this position two years ago. ### LEGION POST TO HAVE OWN HOME

Plans were launched to build a permanent home for Capital Post No. 9, American Legion, at a meeting of the post at the Salem armory last night. The plans, as outlined by Dr. Carleton Smith, sponsor and past commander of the post, received the unanimous endorsement of the assembly.

Only voluntary subscriptions are involved in the plans as outlined, the amount ranging from \$1 to \$25, and extending over a period of 5 years. No definite amount was set as a goal for the campaign, but it was shown that with ordinary effort \$5000 could be raised by July 1, 1925.

Malheur county. The water rights involved total 217, representing 29,252 acres of irrigated land. The order is based on surveys and investigations by the state engineer, testimony taken and other evidence. The order provides that the water used shall not exceed three acre feet per acre during the irrigation season from April 1 to October 15. A further limitation is that not more than one acre foot shall be used for any calendar month prior to June 1 and not more than three-fourths of one acre foot during any calendar month after June 1.

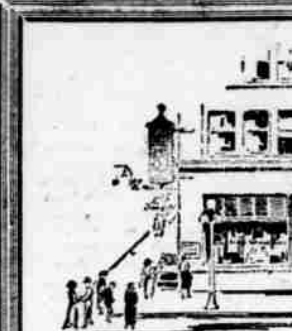
