

SAY FINN RUNNER COMMERCIALIZES AMERICAN TOUR

Chicago, April 24.—A barrage of charges and counter charges has been unleashed on the heels of declarations by officials of Drake University and the University of Chicago that exorbitant demands were made for the track appearance of Paavo Nurmi, Finnish running marvel and his fellow countryman, Sillie Ritala.

It all started when Kenneth L. Wilson, director of athletics at Drake asserted he had refused to pay \$500 expense money for Ritala to appear in races in connection with the Drake relay carnival at Des Moines tomorrow and that it had been hinted Nurmi's appearance could be arranged for a figure equal to transportation from New York to Des Moines and thence to Finland. The declaration was followed by a statement from officials of the University of Chicago that \$1000 had been requested as expenses for the Finnish runner to appear at the national track and field meet at Chicago in June.

Publication of Wilson's charges immediately brought a denial from Hugo Quist, Nurmi's manager, who declared in Los Angeles that he had met Wilson only once and that the expenses of the runners positively were not discussed.

Wilson countered by reiterating his charges that Quist had demanded "an exorbitant sum for the appearance of his runner" and also asserted that he had discussed the matter of expenses for the track meet with Quist on three different occasions.

Wilson said that Quist had "definitely set \$500 as the amount of expense money necessary for the appearance of Ritala." Regarding negotiations for the appearance of Nurmi, Wilson said that while it had been definitely decided that Nurmi could not appear because of conflicting dates, Quist declared during an interview in Chicago January 14 that Nurmi's appearance could be arranged on the extended transportation basis.

BANKRUPTCY PETITION FILED BY LOCAL FIRM

The Capital City Bedding company, Herman Boock and E. E. Lavallee, all of Salem, have filed petitions in federal court asking that Raymond and Helen Burke of Salem be declared bankrupts. This is the sequel to the closing of the People's Furniture store on North Commercial street here last week. Lavallee asserts in the petition he has owing him \$4733.31. Boock claims a debt of \$110 and the Capital City Bedding company has a claim for \$11.

Louis W. Brown of Salem, a laborer, also has filed a petition in voluntary bankruptcy, claiming liabilities of \$572.11 and assets of \$275.

EXECUTIONER HAS TO AWAKEN ARAB VICTIM

Paris, April 24.—An executioner awoke Laurens Laskar, an Arab convicted of murdering two Portuguese and wounding three others, from a sound sleep in LaSante death house here and bade him dress for the guillotine, which was waiting. Extending the usual cigarette and glass of rum, he asked the condemned man:

"What is your wish?"

The condemned Arab replied:

"I wish to be executed."

The guillotine knife fell at 5:45 o'clock.

NEW ENGLAND IS

SHAKEN BY QUAKE

Boston, April 24.—Distinct earth tremors were reported today from several points in southeastern Massachusetts. New Bedford felt shocks accompanied by a rumbling sound at 3:10 o'clock and at Middleboro the phenomenon was timed at 3 o'clock. No damage was reported.

The movement was felt as far in land as Brockton and appeared to follow a line between New Bedford and that city. In Brockton Heights, a suburb, windows and dishes were rattled. The duration of the shocks was reported as being from a few seconds to half a minute.

Providence, R. I., April 24.—New Bedford, Mass., police headquarters reported by long distance telephone this afternoon that a distinct earth shock had been felt in that city at 2:58 a. m. The officer in charge said that there was a rumbling underneath and that the shock lasted the greater part of 20 seconds.
