

TENTATIVE ROSE FESTIVAL PLANS ARE ANNOUNCED

Portland, Apr. 27.—A tentative program for Portland's 1925 Rose Festival, which is to be nearly four times as large and comprehensive as any previous rose carnival, is announced this week by O. W. Mielke, president.

Monday will see the arrival of the grand old battleship "Oregon" with the Queen of Rosaria and her court as passengers, and the opening performance of "Rosaria," pageant of 5000 persons to be presented on a colossal stage in Multnomah field. The queen will be crowned in the final scene.

Tuesday is the opening day of the annual rose show, which is to be enlarged for 1925's augmented festival. Tuesday also will be "Rosebud Day" in the Portland parks where children will present dancing and singing programs. The second performance of "Rosaria" will conclude the day's program.

A regatta on the Willamette river with the largest fleet of racing hydroplane boats in the country is the main event of Wednesday, June 17th. The rose show will be continued and "Rosaria" will be presented.

Portland's florist parade, which this year will be "Rosaria" as a rival for popularity, is scheduled for Thursday. The pageant will have its fourth performance on Thursday night.

Friday is the final day, and the carnival parade, for which a name is being selected, will end the 1925 festival in an orgy of fun. Nothing like this brand new feature of the Rose Festival has been produced in the United States. Every entry in it must contain a emble and most of them will be worthy of a hearty laugh. The final 1925 performance of "Rosaria" on Friday night will conclude the festival.

PLAN SURVEY OF COAST PROJECTS

Washington, April 27.—Chairman of four house committees with jurisdiction over legislation affecting reclamation will assemble on June 3 in San Francisco to begin a two months investigation of various projects in the west.

In the group will be Chairman Crampton of the appropriations sub-committee which drafts the interior department supply bill; Chairman Sinner of the public lands committee; Smith of the irrigation committee and Representative Leavitt of Montana, slated for the chairmanship of the Indian affairs committee. They will be accompanied by the ranking democrat of each committee.

Representative Smith discussed reclamation problems today with President Coolidge, taking with him to the White House Dr. Hiram Newton Savage of Berkeley, Cal., who recently completed a survey of reclamation possibilities in India and Egypt.

QUARANTINE ON STOCK EASED UP

A further modification of the livestock quarantine against shipments from California was made Saturday at a conference between the state livestock sanitary board and representatives of the state of California.

Under the modification cattle, sheep and swine will be permitted to enter Oregon from as far south as Willow, Cal., 300 miles south of the Oregon-California line, if federal certification is made. The animals, however, must be for immediate slaughter after entering Oregon.

A similar action was taken relative to animals coming into the state for grazing. These must have a permit from the Oregon state veterinarian and must be shipped in disinfected cars. After arrival in Oregon the animals shall be under a 20-day quarantine. The order is effective May 6.

OBSERVANCE OF NATIONAL FIRE WEEK IS OPENED

Attention was today called to the fact that the present week, April 27 to May 3, has been designated by President Coolidge as National fire week, and is to be devoted toward education of the public toward prevention of forest fires. Among other things the following "pledge for prevention of forest fires in forests" has been made public:

"1. Matches—I will be sure my match is out. I will break it in two before throwing it away.
"2. Tobacco—I will warn smokers to be sure their pipe ashes, cigar or cigarette stumps are dead before throwing them away. I will warn them not to throw these into brush, leaves, or needles.
"3. Making camp—I will secure a camp fire permit before making a fire. I will build only a small camp fire. I will scrape away the trash from all around it. I will build it in the open, not near a tree or log or near brush.
"4. Leaving camp—I will never leave a camp fire unattended, even for a short time, without quenching it with water and covering it with earth.
"5. Brush of clearing fires—I will never build brush or clearing fires if windy weather or where there is the slightest danger of their escaping from control.
"6. Fighting fires—if I find a fire, I will try to put it out. If I can't, I will get word of it to the nearest United States forest ranger or state fire warden at once."

A few minutes after Smart had relieved the other officers Albers appears and was arrested by Smart. He claims he entered the building through a hole near an old water wheel in Mill creek.
