ACTIVITY IN MARCH ON COAST DECLINES

tries the volume of employment continued smaller than a year ago. Value of building permits issued in 20 cities of the district during March, 1925, was 2.2 per cent greater than in March, 1924, and 23.2 per cent greater than in February, 1925. The latter increase was smaller than that which usually occurs at this season of the year. Building costs, including labor and materials, are estimated to be about 2.4 per cent less than a year ago. Lumber mills of the district, cut, sold and shipped more lumber during March than during February, 1925, the increases being largely seasonal.
Trade at retail, as indicated by rate of 32 department stores in six cities, increased by 26.1 per cent during March, as compared with February. The increase was slightly less than normal according to this bank's index of department store sales adjusted for seasonal variations, which declined from 159 in February to 149 in March, (1919 monthly average equal 100). In March, 1921, the index stood at 125. It is probable that sales during March, 1925, included a greater or proportion of Easter business than did sales in March, 1924, inasmuch as Easter Sunday came on April 12 in 1925, and April 28 in 1924. Improvement in the wholesale trade situation in this district was revealed by March reports of sales of 194 wholesale firms engaged in eleven lines of business. Total value of sales of these firms was 1.5 per cent greater than in March, 1924, whereas corresponding figures for February, 1925, were 8.0 per cent smaller than for February, 1924. All of the eleven lines showed increases, partly because, in sales during March, 1925, compared with February, 1925.

and computation above set forth; to attempt to ascertain the actual number of persons voting for or against the proposed measure. It is the duty of the election officer, which would necessarily involve an inspection and counting of all of the ballots, which you are not authorized to do, ***** or to take the highest number of votes cast for any office, which appears contrary to the provision of the constitution. It is elementary that the law does not require what is impossible, and therefore the counting of the ballots, or to otherwise accurately determine the actual number of votes cast for justice of the supreme court, must be dispensed as not possible, and not authorized.
