

SIDEWALK AND PAVING PLANS PASS COUNCIL

A large number of ordinances providing for the levying of assessments for sidewalk construction were passed by the city council last night. These pertained mainly to sidewalks in Burlington addition, though several other districts were similarly taken care of.

Lots and blocks in Burlington addition that were covered were as follows: Lot 8, block 2; lots 17, 18, 19, 20, 21 and 23, block 2; lots 3, 5 and 12, block 3; lots 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19, block 6. Also the assessment ordinances covered lot 6, block 2, of Broadway, west side of Fairgrounds road, south 42 feet of lot 5, block 16, North Salem, and lot 4, block 2, of Farnish A addition.

Petitions were referred to the appropriate committees for the following projects and improvements asked for by residents of the city:

For a sewer to accommodate the district enclosed by Fricker, Market, 13th and 14th streets.

For the paving of North Fourth from Columbia to Norway.

For a sewer to accommodate property on McCoy avenue and Warner street in Progress addition.

For a light at the intersection of Cottage and Howard streets.

For the paving of Oak street from Commercial to a point 230 feet west of Commercial.

For a drain on Electric avenue and to have the street brought up to standard grade.

For the paving of Columbia street from Broadway to Commercial.

Resolutions were adopted for the construction of sidewalks on the north side of Lincoln street between Commercial and Liberty.

Resolutions were adopted declaring the intention of the council to pave 17th street between Perry and Bellevue, and South Church between Lafelle and Howard.

SEE HOPE FOR RECOGNITION

Tokio, Japan, May 5.—(A. B.)—Victor Kopp, Russian ambassador to Japan, addressing interviewers after he had presented his credentials to the prince regent today, said he believed that recognition of Russia by Japan and other nations would intensify the United States towards recognition of his government. The ambassador added that he did not know the present thought of official Washington on the subject but opinion, generally, in Russia, was that the change of American secretaries of state, was a factor in favor of American recognition.

The Soviet ambassador would not venture an opinion as to when recognition of the Russian government by the United States would take place, but when this condition was brought about the Russian position would remain the same and negotiations would be entirely in the hands of the United States, he said.

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BRITISH PRESS COMMENTS UPON HOUGHTON TALK

London, May 5.—(By Associated Press)—The leading journals of British opinion today emphasize the significance of the address before the Virginia Society last night by the new American ambassador, Alanson B. Houghton, in which he declared that, unless a peace based on good will were reestablished in Europe, he feared the United States would cease to play a sympathetic part in the task of reconstruction.

Fresh from his conferences with President Coolidge and Secretary of State Kellogg the latter of whom he succeeded at the court of St. James, the ambassador reached the crux of his address when he said:

"The full measure of American helpfulness can be obtained only when the American people are assured that the time for destructive methods and policies has passed and that the time for peaceful rebuilding has come."

At his side as he spoke were the British prime minister Stanley Baldwin, the Duke of York, King George's second son, and other eminent and representative Englishmen and the interested envoys of several foreign countries including Germany.

Mr. Houghton's remarks are given in conspicuous typography and earnest editorial comment this morning. The Times says:

"This authoritative reminder that good faith and a real desire for peace are absolutely necessary if active American interest in Europe is to be developed and continued is of great weight at the present moment. It is moreover, in accordance with the instinctive trend of British opinion."

Mr. Houghton's significant speech has far greater direct political value than a torrent of rhetoric.

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ACID THROWER SENT TO PRISON

Los Angeles, Cal., May 5.—One to fourteen years in San Quentin penitentiary loomed ahead of Mrs. Bernice Lundstrom Day today as the result of her conviction in superior court yesterday of throwing acid into the face of her husband, Darby Day Jr., during a domestic quarrel in Beverly Hills last February. Sentence will be pronounced Thursday.
