BONDS SUPPOSED PART OF CHAPMAN LOOT, ARE FOUND

New York, May 8.—Bonds that formed part of the loot of Gerald Chapman, convicted murderer and mail bandit, were recovered today with the arrest of John J. Phalan, charged with grand larceny in connection with the First National bank of Lincoln, Long Island, on some of the stolen collateral.

Nassau county authorities said the number on some of the bonds deposited by Phalan corresponded with those on bonds stolen in the sensational lower Broadway mail truck robbery, in which Chapman and two pals were charged with having swiped with \$2,400,000 worth of loot. Other bonds were believed to have been taken in a raid of the Wilton Trust company at Wilton, Maine, in 1923. This robbery also was laid at the door of Chapman and his associates.

Phalan who is 37 years old, was arrested in a cafe at Seventeenth avenue and 125th street, Harlem, today.

JAPAN ON RECORD FOR PROHIBITION OF GAS WARFARE

Geneva, May 7.—Japan went on record today as favoring a strict interdiction of the use of poison gas in war. D. Matsuda, Japanese delegate to the league of nations international conference for the control in traffic in arms and munitions, made this declaration in a speech ardently supporting the proposal made yesterday by Representative Theodore Burton of Ohio, head of the American delegation, that all export of poison gas for use in war be prohibited.

The American proposal was referred to two sub-committees, military and judicial. The Polish amendment condemning the use of disease bacteria in warfare, was referred to the same committee.

Matsuda said that Japanese already is a party to the poison gas agreement made during the Washington conference and declared in prohibition the exportation of poison gas for war purposes. It also should be understood that such methods of warfare are forbidden by international law. He urged the legal committee to take up the aspect of the problem thoroughly.

The Turkish delegation heartily supported the American proposal, but sided with the Hungarian delegation that the rights of states that do not manufacture to employ gas if they are so attacked should be respected.

SITUATION IN MOROCCO GOOD

Paris, May 8.—(A. P.)—The situation in French Morocco, where Marshal Lyautey is endeavoring to drive El-Krim's Rifian invaders back into the Spanish zone, is said in the latest dispatches to be as satisfactory as possible.

The Rifians, however, are giving the French more trouble than expected and are reported to be receiving reinforcements, notably on the French left wing, which up to the present has not met with much difficulty.

The assembling of large forces of Rifians has been observed in the region of Ouzazza indicating that General Colombat's column is likely to encounter greater opposition. Ouzazza is sixty miles northwest of Fez, and near the border.

Advice from Tetan in the Spanish zone, show that the Spanish troops are continuing to blockade the rebels, and have captured several of the convoys.
