JUDGES PLAN TO CURB ACTIVITY OF NEWSPAPERS

Chicago, May 12—Rules prohibiting taking of newspaper photographs in courtrooms and barring the use of typewriters, telegraph, telephone or radio instruments in sending forth news matter were before the judges of the superior, circuit and criminal courts for passage.

The judges planned the action as the first step in the program destined to reflect in the newspapers a dignified administration of justice.

Typewriters and telegraph instruments which have been condemned especially, have been used extensively in the past, particularly during the trials of Loeb and Leopold for the Frank murder and the W. E. D. Stocka case.

"With such an opening wedge," said Attorney Andrew W. Sheriff, of the board of managers of the Chicago Bar association which is sponsoring the movement "the moves will be easy. The opener making a mockery or source of amusement of a solemn judicial proceeding, or presenting revolting details of sensational trials, or of depicting judges in undignified tirades, or of describing lawyers in fisticuffs and lowly wrangling, will in time disappear."
