

### LOCAL FIRMS GET CONTRACTS FOR NEW Y BUILDING

Contracts for general construction and for wiring of the new Salem Y. M. C. A. building were awarded yesterday afternoon. Work on general construction was awarded to Wechter and Hughes. The Salem Electric company was given the wiring contract. Both are local firms.

The plumbing contract, which was to have been awarded yesterday was held over for a few days.

The bid entered by Wechter and Hughes was for \$89,320. The electric company bid \$2,697.90.

Actual work of construction will begin immediately upon completion of the excavation of the building site, which is expected to be this week. It is understood that the contractors are anxious to begin as soon as possible.

Yesterday's awards were made by the building committee of the local Y. M. C. A., appointed for that special purpose. A general supervisor will be secured to inspect all work that is done on the building.

### WILL TEST ETHYL GAS FOR SAFETY

Washington, May 21.—(By Associated Press)—Surgeon General Cummings of the public health service is expected to appoint soon a commission of seven to determine whether use of ethyl gas as a motor fuel produces injurious effects.

Appointment of the commission was requested in a resolution adopted yesterday by a conference called by the surgeon general to discuss the subject.

Action of the ethyl gas corporation in suspending distribution of its product until a decision is reached regarding its possible dangers, was endorsed by the conference as "wise."

Speakers at the meeting presented statistics to show comparatively few ill effects had resulted to persons handling the gas and to show that its use is becoming urgent, through diminution of the petroleum supply.

Ritzau, president of the company and one of the heaviest stockholders, against the concern, alleging that it was on the verge of bankruptcy and that a receiver be appointed. At a meeting of stockholders here today it was decided to turn over the plants to the Clackamas County Fruitgrowers' association for the coming season, with Loomis in charge.
