

### WAR SERVICE NO DOOR OPENER TO NATURALIZATION

Washington, May 26.—(A. P.)—Japanese and other Asiatics who served in the United States army, navy or coast guard during the World War are not entitled to naturalization, the supreme court has decided.

Privileges extended under the basic naturalization laws, the court said, were specifically limited to aliens who were "free white persons of African descent."

A person of the Japanese race, born in Japan, is not eligible to hold the special privilege extended for military service since the law authorizing such exemption referred directly to the alien classification set up under the naturalization laws.

Washington, May 26.—(A. P.)—The United States is not entitled to priority in bankruptcy proceedings for debts other than taxes, the supreme court has held in cases from South Carolina involving the bankrupt estate of Charles F. Joyd company and from New York involving Knapp, Knoche & Kuhne, bankrupts.

Washington, May 26.—(A. P.)—Chinese wives and the minor children of Chinese merchants residing here are entitled to admission, but the Chinese wives of American citizens are not entitled to admission into the country under the new immigration act, the supreme court ruled.

Washington, May 26.—(A. P.)—The fair average value of the net assets of corporations and not the average market value of shares of stock must be used by the government in assessing capital stock taxes, the supreme court declared Monday in a case from New York city brought by the Ray Consolidated Copper company.

### DRY NAVY TO BE STRENGTHENED

Chicago, May 26.—(By Associated Press)—The government's rum navy is to be augmented on three fronts—the Atlantic, the Pacific and the Great Lakes. Coincident with reports from New York that five large liquor laden ships had left the blockade area of the eastern coast, Lincoln C. Andrews, chief of federal prohibition enforcement, announced at El Paso that plans had been laid to expand the enforcement fleet on the Atlantic to 100 or more craft.

Mr. Andrews also said that the sea prohibition forces on the Pacific coast will be enlarged to make available to the coast guard at least one boat for every liquor steamer ship off shore. The enforcement chief, who was in El Paso as a member of the Mexican-American border conference, departed for New York to personally supervise the speeding up of prohibition activities there.

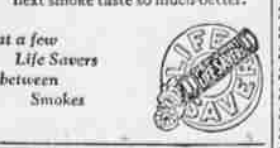

### RIFFIAN DRIVE IS REDOUBLED

Paris, May 26.—(By Associated Press)—Abd-el-Krim, Riffian chieftain, has redoubled his preparations for a new battle in which he hopes to throw at least 30,000 men against Marshal Lyautey's defending forces in French Morocco, according to the latest news.

His most recent move, the French intelligence service learns, is to order all the natives in the western part of the Spanish zone to form a harka of 3000 or 4000, the greater part of which will go to the French zone in the region of Queznan, the rest to face the Spaniards.

His propaganda section likewise is most active. He is said to be having his genealogy worked out to prove his descent from Mohammed, the prophet, and he blesses the weapons of his warriors. All of this the French say, is done to incite religious fervor in the dropping spirits of the tribes of whose support he is becoming uncertain.

Fez dispatches say the Yehia tribesmen admit the loss of more than 700 dead at the Quergha river in the recent sharp fighting. This tribe is also reported to have attacked the Spaniards in the region of Tapalet.

The Spaniards are also said to be actively preparing for a drive against the rebel stronghold of Alhucemas.
