

RIVER STEAMER SOLD AT AUCTION BRINGS BUT \$2100

The river steamer Relief, which sank on December 24, while moored in the Willamette river at the foot of Court street, was sold at public auction for \$2100 yesterday afternoon. The boat was bid in by D. W. Ridgway as agent for Durham & Bates, who are Portland agents for the Globe & Rutgers Fire Insurance company of New York, who in turn are said to be agents for Loyde of London.

Litigation has been in process ever since the boat sank. Yesterday's auction, which was conducted by Harry V. Reed of Portland, chief deputy United States marshal, was made by order of the federal court at Portland to satisfy a judgment given by default in favor of the insurance company when the company brought suit to collect \$3249.26 and costs, alleging that the sum had been expended in raising and repairing the Relief, and that the boat had been deliberately allowed to sink by its owners.

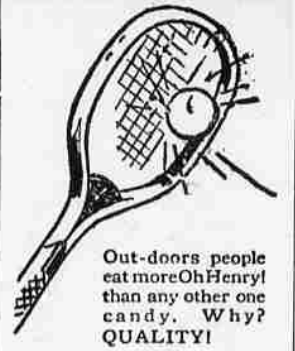
It is thought that if more than the sum allowed in the judgment had been bid at yesterday's auction, the representatives of the insurance company would have let the boat go.

The Relief was taken to Portland within a few days, it is stated, although the most bitter

legal fight is still ahead. Former owners of the boat, Charles F. Schaub, A. Sweet and Richard Clayton, are now suing to recover the full amount, \$30,000, for which the Relief was insured. It is suspected that the owners allowed the suit brought by the insurance company to go by default with the idea in view that they might possibly stand a better chance to secure the amount of their premium. Legal authorities state that under the former status the owners could not hope to secure the entire \$20,000. The most they could have hoped for would be to have the boat put back into condition as good as it was before the so-called accident occurred. Whether they have, by allowing the boat to be sold at public auction, seriously increased their chances to collect the policy, is a question which will be determined when the case comes up for trial.

Most of the argument centers around the question of whether or not the owners did deliberately

allow their boat to sink. There were several other bidders on hand yesterday afternoon, but none thought enough of the boat to raise the first bid, made by a representative of the insurance company, who started the bidding at \$1000. All bidding was done by representatives of the insurance company, the two bidding back and forth at each other until the sum of \$2100 was reached. It was obviously immaterial to them how much they bid, so long as it did not go above \$3249.26.

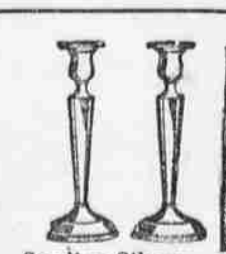
