

MOROCCAN WAR GROWS SERIOUS AND EXTENSIVE

New York, June 11.—(A. P.)—Morocco, trouble spot of north-western Africa, is again engaging the serious attention of the European chancelleries. Checkmated in their fight with the Spaniards, Abd-el-Krim and his doughty warriors of the Rif recently turned their rifles and lances against the French. Now they face the prospect of having to stand off the trained legions of both these powers, with the jaws of a pincer movement closing on them, from the north and south.

A Franco-Spanish conference to consider such joint action is opening at Madrid next Monday, with both military and naval experts in attendance. Meanwhile, the French premier and war minister, M. Painleve, has arrived by airplane at Rabat, seat of the French governor-general, to see for himself the disposition of the troops and the methods used in checking the Rifian invasion of the protectorate.

Forced to adopt a defensive campaign by the attitude of the parliamentary majority in the chamber of deputies, the French have been content in the last few weeks to hold a line along the Ouergha river and thus balk Abd-el-Krim in his desire to reach Fez and to there proclaim himself sultan.

The Rifian leader took cognizance of Premier Painleve's arrival by opening an attack along a 60-mile front, extending to the extreme east. This indicates a resumption of his attempt to cut the railway leading from Algeria to Fez, on which line the French are dependent for immediate reinforcement and supplies.

A French official communique says the attacks of the tribesmen have thus far been repulsed, but admits that "several small posts had to be abandoned."
