

# REPORTS OF BLACK RUST SEND WHEAT SOARING

## GAIN OF 6 CENTS REGISTERED IN EARLY TRADING

Chicago, June 17.—Reports from Fargo, N. D., that black rust threatened severe crop damage has developed in the Red River valley had much to do with an unusually sharp advance today in the price of wheat. The market here closed strong at an extreme gain of six cents a bushel, July \$1.55 1/2 to \$1.55 1/4.

Even higher prices for wheat were touched on a wave of buying just before the finish. The tip top for the day was \$1.56 1/2, July delivery, an over-night jump of 6 cents a bushel.

Chicago, June 17.—(By Associated Press)—The wheat opening, one cent to 4 1/2 cents higher, July \$1.51 to \$1.53, and September \$1.49 1/2 to \$1.50 1/2, was followed by rapid changes in which July touched \$1.55 1/2 and September \$1.51 1/4.

After opening at 1/4 to 3/8 advance, September \$1.10 to \$1.11, the corn market climbed a little more and then receded somewhat.

Oats started at 1 cent to 2 cents gain, September 49 1/2 to 51 1/2. Later a part of the grain was wiped out.

Provisions were easier. July rose to \$1.56 1/2 but afterward reacted somewhat. The close was unsettled, 2 1/2 to 3 cents net higher, July \$1.55 1/2 to \$1.55 1/4 and September \$1.52 1/2 to \$1.52 1/4.

## EXPECT LARGER PACK OF LOGANS

With almost no holdover on canned loganberries and with fair indications of a market for this year's pack, indications are that the pack on logans will be considerably larger than 1924, according to the estimates of local canners. The fruit this year is of good size and quality and is heavy with moisture.

The stream of logans coming into local canneries which has started during the week will reach its usual midseason volume sometime next week, according to the canners, and with the likelihood that strawberries can be finished by that time, most of the local plants will turn full crews on the logan job next week. The logan season is one of the earliest on record, fully two weeks ahead of the usual heavy run and has been something of a problem for the packers.

Reports from the fields indicate that at least for the first of the season growers will have plenty of pickers as no difficulty has been reported so far in securing workers.

## WEATHER FAVORS ALL GRAIN CROPS

Portland, June 17.—The weather has been generally favorable for small grain, except that hail did some local damage and there was some injury by frost in elevated districts says the weekly Oregon crop report issued here today by the weather bureau.

Winter barley and wheat are ripening slowly.

Most fruits need warmer weather. Raspberries are nearly gone in some places, but are still plentiful in others. Later fruits are slating well.

The first cutting of alfalfa is in the stack in the middle localities and the second crop is starting well, but needs warmer weather.

Early potatoes are in market in increasing quantities, planting of late potatoes continues. Some damage was done by frost to potatoes and gardens in elevated districts, and in a few northeastern localities some hail damage was reported. Gardens need warmer weather. Hops are doing well. Flax is making good growth.

## COMMISSION TO RULE IN CANTON

Canton, June 17.—(A. P.)—The Kuomintang people's party is reported to have decided to abolish the civil government of Canton and place the government in the hands of a commission of seven. This decision, it is understood, was taken at a meeting here last Sunday.

Regarding finance, all funds are to go through the civil treasury, the military commanders being forbidden to levy taxes. Many existing taxes are being abolished and the authorities expect to meet the expenditures without the revenue hitherto received from gambling.

All gaming houses, therefore, are closed, and the laws suppressing opium enforced.

The scheduled anti-foreign demonstration did not materialize here and the strike in Shantien, the British settlement, has been postponed.

Three Killed by Gas. Richmond, Va., June 17.—Three men were killed and two others were overcome by gas here today while engaged in constructing a sewer. Two of the dead lost their lives while trying to save their companion. The two injured were overcome in trying to aid the others.

Portland, June 17.—The butter market is strong with extra cubes half cent higher on local dairy exchange at 4 1/2. Other grades are unchanged.

Egg prices are a half to one cent higher on exchange. Extras were posted at 36 cents and firsts at 35 cents for the day. Futures are unchanged. Current receipts half cent higher at 32 1/2 net. The market is very firm.

## ALL FRUIT CROPS SHORT IS REPORT OF GOVERNMENT

Chicago, June 17.—(By Associated Press)—Fruit crops are short. Apples and peaches as well as peaches are expected to be in lighter supply than last season.

The shortage of fruit is announced today by the United States government bureau of agricultural economics and is stated to be the effect of a severe winter or of spring frosts in some sections and of dry weather in others.

Prospect of fewer peaches than last year is especially apparent. The estimated production is slight by more than 47,000,000 bushels—eleven percent less than in 1924, although half a million bushels above a five year average. Shipping point prices are almost twice those of last year.

Prospect of fewer peaches than last year is especially apparent. The crop appear in the region starting with New Jersey and Pennsylvania, extending to south into Georgia and west through Kentucky, Tennessee and Oklahoma.

Decided gains as compared with last season are reported in the peach production of Missouri and California. The California crop of 10,000,000 bushels may prove the largest since 1922.

## LOGANS COMING ON RAPIDLY NOW

Salem canneries are now receiving their early lots of loganberries and by the middle of next week work on the logans will supersede that of strawberries in the production of local canners who point out that the beginning of the loganberry canning is the earliest on record. This fact has brought difficulty with it for canners are facing the prospect of having the peak of the loganberry land come around the fourth of July when they are expected to shut down for the holiday.

Work on the crop this year is fully two weeks ahead of the usual start. The berries are reported to be large size and heavy with moisture. The prevailing price continues at five cents.

Canners expect that work on the strawberries can be finished in another week and that soon after that time the full crews can be put on the logans.
