

# RADIO ROW OVER; M'MILLAN WILL SAIL TOMORROW

Sydney, N. S., June 25.—(By Associated Press)—With a disagreement over wireless equipment settled with the navy department, Commander Donald B. MacMillan, of the American Arctic expedition is pushing preparations to sail northward tomorrow.

The steamer Bowdoin and Peary are being fueled.

The navy's long wave wireless equipment is being transferred to the Peary from the United States destroyer Putnam, which arrived here last night after a rush trip from Wiscasset, Maine, on orders of Secretary Wilbur. The next stop is Battle Harbor, Labrador, where native Eskimo clothing and boots will be taken aboard for the navigators of the three naval planes. The expedition will be at Etah, Greenland, whence the vast area, between the north pole and Alaska will be explored by air for an undiscovered continent.

Secretary Wilbur yesterday issued an ultimatum that if the long wave spark wireless equipment was not carried the navy's personnel and planes were to disembark here. He said he considered this equipment on the Peary essential for the safety of the navy men and that Commander MacMillan had agreed to carry this equipment.

Bristol, Va.-Tenn., June 25.—(AP)—In a pitched battle between moonshiners and officers today on Paint creek, 16 miles below Greenville, Tenn., Deputy Sheriff Hunter Rollins was killed and Emanuel Rollins, his father, and C. P. Carter were critically wounded.

Four autos carrying heavily armed men were rushed to the scene and federal prohibition Agent Shelton has asked for assistance from Johnson City officials. Shelton said more trouble is expected when the officers reach Paint creek, the scene of several similar battles in the past year.

# FUNDING OF WAR DEBT HELD SURE

Washington, June 25.—The Italian war debt to the United States today became the seventh to be formally started on its way to a funding settlement when Ambassador de Martino and Mario Alberti, representing the Italian government, had an engagement with Secretary Mellon and Under Secretary of the American debt commission, to begin the discussion.

The Italian obligation is approximately \$2,138,000,000 and the Italian government desires that its payment be spread over a period of years. The length of time to be allowed therefore constitutes one of the important phases with which this and future conferences have to deal.

It already was known that Italy was pressing for a delay in beginning of remittance. Neither the treasury nor the embassy would indicate, however, the duration of the proposed moratorium but it was said in some quarters to be ten years. Secrecy is to surround all of the conferences on the Italian debt.

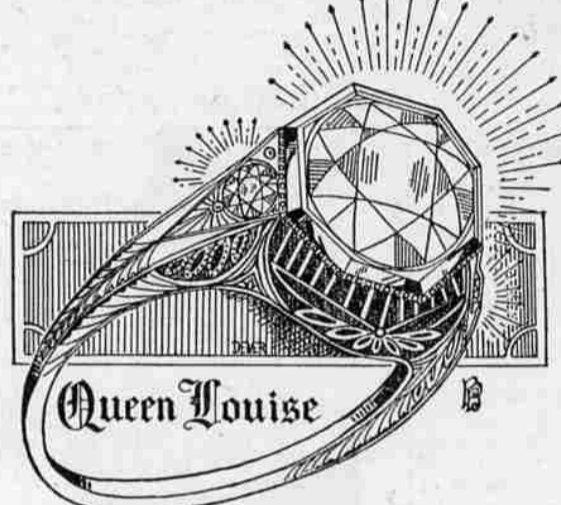

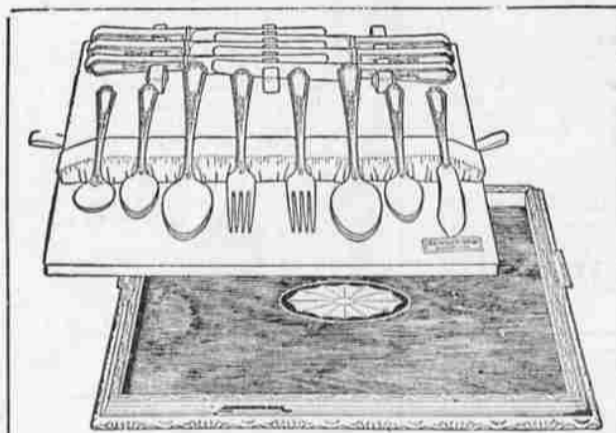

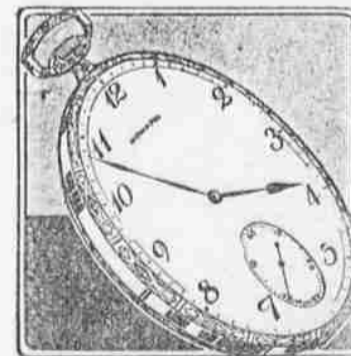
