

### FORD FAILS TO BID ON VESSELS

Washington, July 1.—Bids from 20 individuals and companies were opened by the fleet corporation Tuesday for sale of 200 shipping board vessels for scrapping, but the name of Henry Ford did not appear.

No explanation was available as to why Mr. Ford, who had indicated an intention of bidding did not submit a tender and Chairman O'Connor of the shipping board said he had received no communication from the manufacturer on the subject.

The bids were for varying numbers of the vessels under varying conditions and differed widely. Only one bid for the entire 200 was received, it being from the Boston & Iron Metal company of Baltimore for a blanket sale at \$1,370,000. The General Metal Supply company of Oakland, Cal., made an offer for 134 vessels, under varying conditions which ran from \$42000 to \$6000 each.
