

COOLIDGE WILL KEEP HANDS OFF LOCAL CONTESTS

Swampscott, Mass., July 10.—(AP)—President Coolidge does not intend to play an active role in congressional elections.

This determination holds even in his own congressional district in Massachusetts, in which a vacancy now exists as a result of the recent death of George B. Church.

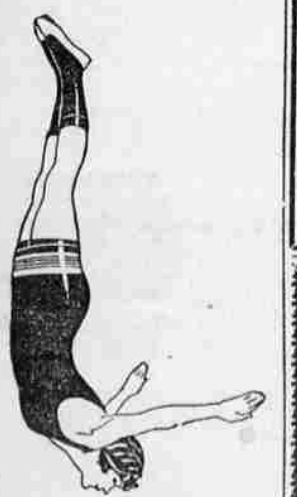

Bowles of Springfield seek his seat are known to be somewhat vexing to the executive despite his close personal friendship for Mr. Bowles. Mr. Bowles' error here yesterday with Frank W. Stearns, intimate friend of the president and Thomas White, also close to the executive.

Standing pat on his policy, Mr. Coolidge has made it known that he will not speak at the Essex county newspaper editors' outfit to be held Saturday at Lake Attitash, which Senator Butler will attend. It was the general belief that on this occasion the latter would stage a formal opening of his campaign for re-election to the contest to be waged a year hence when he probably will be opposed by David I. Walsh, former democratic senator from this state.

Senator Butler was the president's choice for manager in the last campaign and when Senator Lodge died he was appointed to the senate.

MONDELL GETS RELEASE ASKED

Swampscott, Mass., July 10.—(AP)—Acceptance by President Coolidge of the resignation of Frank W. Mondell as a director of the War Finance corporation is announced at the summer White House.

The following letter from the president to Mr. Mondell was made public:

"I feel that I must comply with your wish so earnestly expressed that your resignation as director of the War Finance corporation be accepted. It may take effect July 15 next as you suggested.

"This affords me the opportunity to express my appreciation of the valuable service you have rendered while serving as director. You brought to the solution of the many problems encountered in your wide experience in governmental affairs and you have earnestly and industriously labored at the difficult task.

PIERCE FAVORS UNIFORM TAXES FOR ALL STATES

Governor Pierce has announced his position on levying of inheritance and income taxes by the federal government and also by state governments.

This he did in an interview on the plan proposed by the Georgia country bankers' association.

Governor Pierce said:

"I believe in a strong inheritance tax. It ought to be uniform in every state and ought to be a national tax, collected by government machinery, and should be apportioned, part to the government and part to the state. I believe the same with respect to the income tax."

The resolution adopted by the Georgia country bankers' association, which was submitted to Governor Pierce for his opinion declared that the inheritance tax provision of the federal tax measure should be replaced. The resolution follows:

"Whereas, we affirm our confidence in the wisdom of the founders of our government in recom-

ending a separation of tax source as between federal and state jurisdiction which has had the unanimous endorsement of our statesmen and the approval of custom from the beginning of government to the present time.

"Whereas we remind congress of the danger of trespassing upon the unwritten covenant in time of peace without the consent of the states.

"Therefore be it resolved, first

—that the inheritance tax provision of the federal tax measure be repealed, leaving this source of revenue to the states for individual action as they may see fit.

"Second—We authorize the chair to appoint such committee and invite the co-operation of such organization and agencies as he may deem wise in making effective these resolutions."
