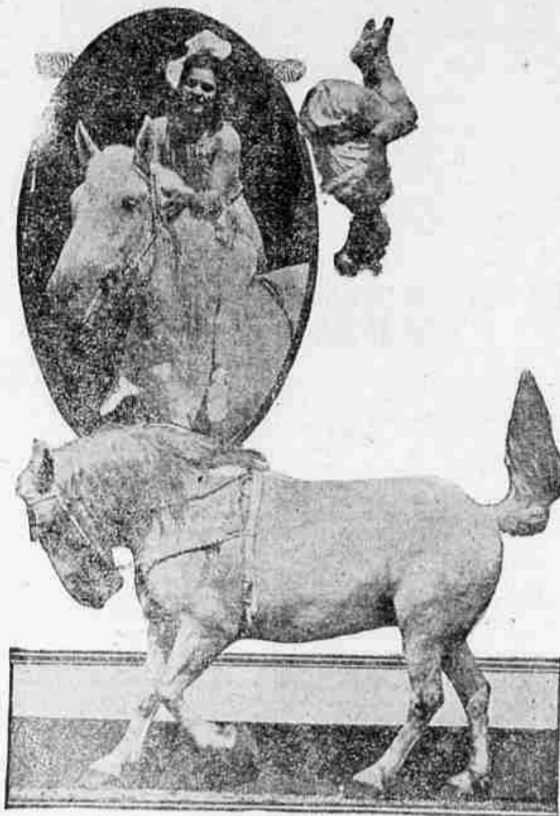


# May Wirth Works For Four Years to Learn Difficult Trick



May Wirth, the sensational young Australian girl somersault rider, with the Ringling-Barnum circus, coming to Salem Saturday, August 29th. Miss Wirth heads a corps of three score riders with the circus.

Four years spent in hard work mastering one difficult trick? That was the triumphant achievement of May Wirth, somersaulting equestrienne of the Ringling Brothers and Barnum & Bailey circus, who accomplishes the phenomenal feat of leaping from the ground to the bare back of her flying steed, with her feet encased in 18-inch baskets. And then, standing erect, the little rider maintains her pose still basket-bound, while her horse gallops as fast as he can go.

It was a matter of professional conscience, as well as personal pride, that impelled Miss Wirth to accomplish this feat. She simply made up her mind to do it and she stuck stubbornly until she succeeded. In the same spirit, a virtuoso like Paderewski or an inventor like Edison attains the seemingly impossible.

It is but natural that May Wirth should have risen to fame as the supreme equestrienne of the day. By descent, she belongs to the royal race of the savadist arena. Her father was a famous rider, her maternal grand-father was one of the first bareback riders, and her great-uncle lived to hold the monopoly of the circus in Australia for half a century. Kinfolk and connections of the Wirth family are still flourishing in the Antipodes.

There are more than seventy expert equestrians with "the greatest show of earth" this season. Native-born and European riders who have perfected their art to the highest degree will be found enrolled on the circus roster. The Heffensch sisters, the Ernestos,

the Wirth family, Madame Ella Bradna, the Clarks and George Harnford family are among the international celebrities that will be seen here next Saturday, August 29th.

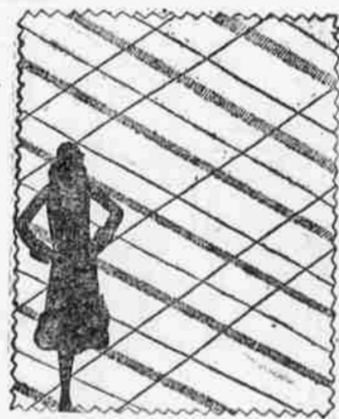

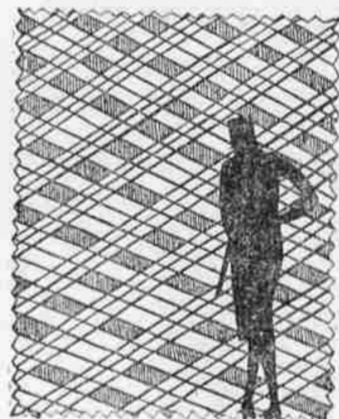
