

### CROSS GARDENS TO CONTAIN ALL OREGON SHRUBS

While the beauties of the rock work and other gardens at the new home of Mr. and Mrs. Curtis B. Cross on Fairmount hill have been viewed by hundreds of motorists from the street, not so many are familiar with what they are doing with the large three quarters of a block surrounding the home.

They have the ambition of placing in their natural park by the home every wild Oregon shrub of beauty that grows. As a result Mr. and Mrs. Cross have made numerous motor trips for hundreds of miles, scouring woods and forests in the Willamette valley, on the coast, in eastern and southern Oregon and even into Coos and Curry county gathering roots which have been brought back carefully preserved in their natural soil and so far every one has been nursed into life among the trees of the estate.

One of the prized wild shrub possessions is a collection of five different kinds of huckleberry bushes. The ordinary citizen only knows that a huckleberry is a huckleberry, but Mr. Cross states he believes there are other varieties and he is after a complete collection, no matter the distance to be traveled in the state to get it together.

He also is constructing a log cabin at one corner of the natural park which will be beautified with rustic devices. Ownership of the log cabin is an ambition which dates back to his early childhood.

In addition to the development of the natural park at the rear Mr. and Mrs. Cross also plan on putting in a number of additional formal gardens to enhance the many beautiful ones already established at the place. The present development has all been the work of a single year.

### TILDEN DEFEATS FRANCE IN SENSATIONAL BATTLE

Leonard Wood, Jr., Bankrupt  
New York, Sept. 10.—Leonard Wood, Jr., son of the governor general of the Philippines today filed a voluntary petition in bankruptcy in Brooklyn. He estimated his liabilities at \$14,585 and assets at \$742, divided as follows: \$91 cash; \$1 in bank; \$306 in open accounts, and an I. O. U. for \$150.

### FRENCH GUNS IN PLACE FOR DRIVE UPON RIFFIANS

Fez, French Morocco, Sept. 11.—(A. P.)—The intensive artillery preparation by the French on a 15-mile front in the central section of the battle line in Morocco has been completed and the French troops are beginning to get under way in the much-heralded drive against the rebellious Moors. Offensives also are being undertaken by the French at other points, but they are on a smaller scale than the operation in the valley of the River Ouergha. The Riffians on the Ouergha valley front made aware by the artillery preparations of the approach of the French drive are rasking in reinforcement.

Two thousand rebel riflemen have been seen in the Bab-hocelne region and trenches are being hurriedly dug by the tribesmen at Taounat. The tribesmen continue active on the western front. They are said to have made another attack on Issual which was repelled by the garrison aided by American filters and other air squadrons.

The latest reports from Madrid are to the effect that the tribesmen have begun a violent offensive against the Spaniards in the north around Tetuan, capital of the Spanish protectorate. According to Informaciones, the organ of the Spanish military directorate in Madrid, the purpose

of the Moorish attack was to divert Spanish troops from the Alhucemas front where Abd-el-Krim's capital, Ajdir is menaced.
