

LICENSE NEEDED TO WEAR TURBAN IN TURKEY NOW

Constantinople, Oct. 17.—(A. P.)—Henceforth it will be necessary to obtain a license to wear a turban in Turkey. The ex-dervishes, whose cults recently have been suppressed, the Hadjis (those who have made the pilgrimage to Mecca), the fruit dealers, and even beggars, who in the past have affected the turban, no longer will have the privilege of wearing it.

New the turban may be worn only by Turkish priests. The 1200 priests in Constantinople have been required to take out permits which bear their pictures, their names and the names of the mosques at which they officiate. Anyone wearing a turban without a permit is arrested. Many of those who have worn turbans are objecting strenuously to the new order, taking the ground that they are sure to catch cold when they unswath heads that always have been swathed.

The general desire of the populace to discard the old time costume has become so contagious that the rabbis of Constantinople have decided to wear modern civilian dress when outside the synagogues. Their flowing black gowns and tall cylindrical hats no longer are to be seen in the streets of the city.

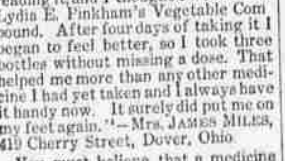

CLAIM IMAGE OF MADONNA SEEN ON CHURCH WALL

Mineola, N. Y., Oct. 17.—(AP)—Visitors by the thousands are flocking to St. Martin's Roman Catholic church at Central Park, a hamlet near here, and there is talk of making the little whitewashed building a shrine church.

A stain on the plaster wall, the visitors say, has assumed the shape of a Madonna and child. They point out a little spot at her throat as the halo above the child's head, a cross held by the child, and a halo, appearing above the virgin's head.

The Rev. Daniel H. Dwyer, pastor of the church, is seeking an explanation of how the stain assumed this shape.

"I see no more than any one else does," he said, "but certainly the image of the Christ child is clear."

Some of the parishioners say the details are becoming more distinct with the passing days. One suggestion is that the stain itself was a natural result of exposure to storm when the building was under construction a year ago. The supernatural element figures large in the parishioners' discussions. Already among the numerous visitors are cripples and invalids hoping for miraculous cures, although

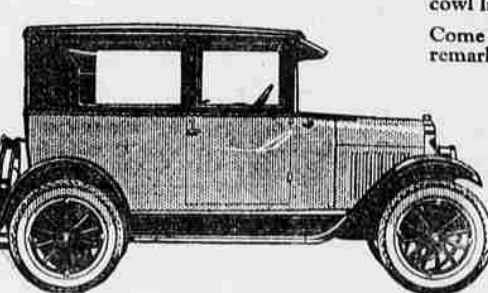
