

SATURDAY TILTS TO SEE LEADERS AGAIN IN ACTION

San Francisco, Oct. 29.—(AP)—The approach of another week's football engagements, today saw three teams in the dash for Pacific coast conference honors. They are Washington, California and Stanford.

Despite the fact that Idaho retains a perfect conference standing, with two wins and no defeats, its chances for a title are not regarded seriously. The Vandals were trounced last Saturday, 12 to 3, by Gonzaga university.

Huskies Rated High
Washington, leading in the north as a powerful threat, has not been conquered. It has five victories, besides a six to six tie with Nebraska, to its credit. The Huskies have rolled up 323 points this year against 13 for their opponents and defeated Montana 30 to 19 in their only conference game.

Both California and Stanford have a clean conference slate with one victory each to its credit but both have tasted the bitter pill of defeat in pre-season games. In each instance the San Francisco Olympic club was the victorious team. The Bears have won four games for a total of 116 points while 15 points have been scored against them. Four wins and 87 points are credited to the Cardinals and they have allowed 21 points.

Oregon Plays Stanford
Next Saturday the Huskies will match their strength with Washington State College at Pullman for home honors. California journeys to Los Angeles for a lark with the weaker Pomona college team. The Cardinals are preparing to surmount an obstacle as presented by the University of Oregon eleven when they tangle at Palo Alto Saturday. In this not much difficulty is expected as the northern team has been on the short end of three different scores which includes a 28 to 0 defeat by California last Saturday.

Oregon Prepares
Eugene, Or., Oct. 29.—With the California game a bitter memory, the University of Oregon football team is working hard this week in preparation for the game Saturday with Stanford university at Palo Alto.

According to the stories coming from the south Stanford is expecting a fairly easy time of it, and this hasn't taken very well with the Oregon team. Every man it seems, has resolved to show the Cardinals a real fight just for spite and the team as a whole is making a desperate effort to bring about better teamwork.

STADIUM IS PLANNED FOR ROSE FESTIVAL

Portland, Oct. 29.—(AP)—Plans were outlined at the annual meeting of the Rose Festival association last night for construction of a stadium in which to stage pageants and other features of the fete, as well as civic functions which demand a greater area and a greater seating capacity than is now available.

J. R. Raley, general manager of the 1925 festival, said that a tract of ground not less than 500 feet

square should be provided for a stadium; that it should be equipped with a covered stage 200 feet wide and that the seating capacity of the amphitheater should be 20,000. A rough estimate of the cost of a permanent structure with lighting and all other equipment would be approximately \$150,000, he said.
