

RHINELANDER'S BRIDE DENIES FRAUD CHARGE

White Plains, N. Y., Oct. 29.—(A. P.)—Mrs. Alice Beatrice Jones Rhinelander, housemaid, whose marriage last year to Leonard Kip Rhinelander, member of one of New York's oldest and most prominent families, caused a society sensation, apparently is not opposing the charge in his suit for annulment that she is of negro extraction. Instead she may be expected to base her defense on the contention that no fraud was perpetrated.

This disclosure, as well as the fact that young Rhinelander has been disinherited, was made yesterday in a hearing on motion of Mrs. Rhinelander's attorney, for \$15,000 additional attorney's fees, of which \$3,500 was granted.

Young Rhinelander's attorneys have spent \$20,000 in tracing the paternity of their client's father-in-law, they said, and found that birth certificates in the West Indies and England recorded all members of the family as negroes.

"Not a penny was spent by the defense to sustain its contention that the defendant is not of negro blood," said Isaac N. Mills, an attorney for the husband, "although \$3,500 was granted by the court for this purpose."

HIGHWAY BOARD LETS CONTRACTS

Portland, Or., Oct. 29.—(A. P.)—The state highway commission has awarded contracts for road work in eastern and central Oregon, including the last section of surfacing of The Dalles-California highway. The awards follow:

Lena-Vinson section of the Oregon-Washington highway, in Morrow and Umatilla counties, 15.1 miles of grading; unit No. 1 to John Hamphire, Grants, Pac., \$84,450; unit No. 2, Palmbrook & Nicholson, Tacoma, \$31,809.40.

Hereford Hill-Gulch section of the Baker-Unity highway in Baker county, 12.54 miles of grading; H. E. Cornell, Boise, \$126,689.50.

Lafine-Corral Springs section of The Dalles-California highway in Deschutes and Klamath counties, 28.2 miles of surfacing both units to Carl Nyberg, Spokane, \$203,000. This contract, however, is to be approved by the bureau of public roads.

East unit of the Beatty-Drew Valley section of the Klamath Falls-Lakeview highway in Klamath and Lake counties, 14.6 miles of clearing, L. J. Roosen, Portland, \$8500.

Shop and buildings at Coquille, for the Roosevelt coast highway, Olds Construction company, Tillamook, \$12,895.21, and at Klamath Falls, for the Dalles-California highway, Olds Construction company, \$11,554.71.

The highway commission lets yesterday ordered a survey by the

state of a proposed short route to Tillamook. After this action was taken promoters of a proposed toll road withdrew their application for a franchise for a toll road down the Wilson river.

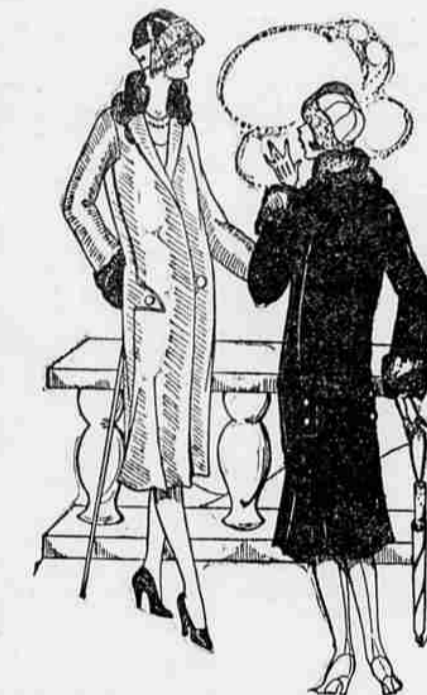
