

SPIRITUALIST, BLIND 16 YEARS COMING SUNDAY

Mrs. Anna Lee Snyder and Miss Marguerite Carney, who will arrive in Salem this week to take charge of the Sunday evening services at the First Spiritualist church here.

Perhaps all of the Spiritualist faith already know both the Portland women who will be the Sunday guests of the local church. Both the visitors are blind and have been in spiritualistic work for many years. Mrs. Snyder lost her sight sixteen years ago when eye rheumatism robbed her of eyes. Since that time she has been actively engaged in her present vocation—that of a psychic reader and lecturer. For a number of years she attended the Salem school for the blind and it is to this institution that she gives full credit for her new and fresh outlook on life. In speaking of her blindness, Mrs. Snyder said: "Almost everyone looks upon blindness as the most tragic sorrow of life. When the doctors first told me that I would never again be able to see, I was so horrified, so utterly crushed and stricken that I prayed for death. I didn't want to live, to feel and stumble and grope my way through darkened days of life. Today I can look back upon my years of anguish and smile. It took the encouragement of a single loyal friend and the inestimable help of the Salem school for the blind to make me see that life was still worth the living. Although I have two glass eyes, although I, too, once thought blindness the greatest of human tragedies, today I am happy in my work for I have found joy in serving, cheering, helping others to help themselves."

Miss Marguerite Carney, who will be with Mrs. Snyder, is the Oregon girl, blind since birth, who has won a year's scholarship which will take her to Chicago to study and to continue the training of her voice. Miss Carney has a rare soprano voice whose richness of tone and fineness of timbre is very unusual. She will be accompanied at the piano by Miss Pauline Snyder, daughter of the blind medium.

Both sightless visitors are natives of Oregon and have spent all their lives in this state. They will conduct their services in the W. O. D. hall on Liberty street. Miss Carney will give her opening musical selection at 7:30 p. m.
