

OREGON BUILDS UP DEFENSE FOR ANNUAL CLASSIC

University of Oregon, Eugene, Nov. 12.—(Special.)—Working on a mud strewn field the University of Oregon football squad is endeavoring to make ready for the Oregon Aggie invasion Saturday. The game is the outstanding event of the eleventh annual homecoming this week end, and the advance sale of tickets indicates that fully 15,000 people will see the game.

Probably several new faces will appear in the Oregon lineup, as the coaches are working on a combination to withstand the Beavers' attack.

With this in view Harry Leavitt veteran substitute but unknown in varsity ranks, has been shifted from prospective fullback to a

first string guard. Leavitt is taking the place of Gene Shields, who was injured in practice Monday afternoon.

Leavitt was given a try at guard because of his fighting qualities. Baz Williams, line coach, declares Leavitt is a comer as he is one of the surest tacklers on the entire squad, and in case he does start the Aggie game he will play guard on the offensive but will be pulled into the backfield on the defensive to play full back.

"Oregon has been weak in its defensive this season, and one of

our greatest problems is to bring this weakness." Every man gradually is being worked into a fighting mood by the coaches. Players, varsity and scrubs alike, are being shifted to the first string and then back.

Mautz and Smith are holding down the ends, and are almost assured of starting Saturday. Sinclair, Dixon, Mangum, Kerns and Warren are competing for the tackles.

Bailey, Bliss, Leavitt, Socolofsky and Shields are fighting for guard. Johnson and Carter are

working at center.

The backfield probably will be composed of Jones, full; Anderson, quarter, and Wetzel and Hodgen, or Vitus, halves. However, Kiminki, Harrison, and Langworthy may be sent in during the fray.
