PLANS ARE LAID FOR PERMANENT HEALTH LEAGUE

A committee consisting of Dr. Henry Morris, Dr. E. E. Fisher, Dr. R. Lee Wood, Mrs. W. F. Fargo and Mrs. F. A. Elliott was last night appointed to organize a local branch of a permanent health council for Marion county.

The committee was appointed at a special meeting at the Salem chamber of commerce rooms, at which members of the staff of the Marion county child health demonstration were present and spoke briefly on the purpose of the county health council. Dr. Walter H. Brown, head of the demonstration, stated that the council is not to be for the purpose of superceding any health organization already in existence, but to be an organization by which and through which they may all work more efficiently and effectively.

The local branch of the health council will consist, when organized, of one representative of each organization already existing in Salem.

The present plan involves dividing Salem into three districts, with a nurse from the Marion county child health demonstration in each district.
