

### BEARCATS MAKE READY FOR GAME WITH OLD RIVALS

A light workout, with particular work on defense against an aerial attack, featured the practice of the Bearcat football aggregation Thursday afternoon, in preparation for the clash with Pacific on Sweetland field here Saturday. Saturday's game will close the season for the Bearcats so far as Salem is concerned. Games are being considered with the University of British Columbia and Bellingham normal school, but if either clash takes place it will be at Bellingham or at Vancouver, B. C., not at Salem.

Pacific is known to have a fast team consisting largely of veterans, the backfield especially being formidable. They are expected to resort frequently to the forward pass.

Sweining, who came out for football late in the season, will start the game at halfback for Willamette and will call the signals. Heidel, because of his passing ability, will hold down the quarterback position. C. Zeller will start the game at fullback and Fasnacht, who has been out of the lineup all season because of an injury, will probably play halfback during at least part of the game.

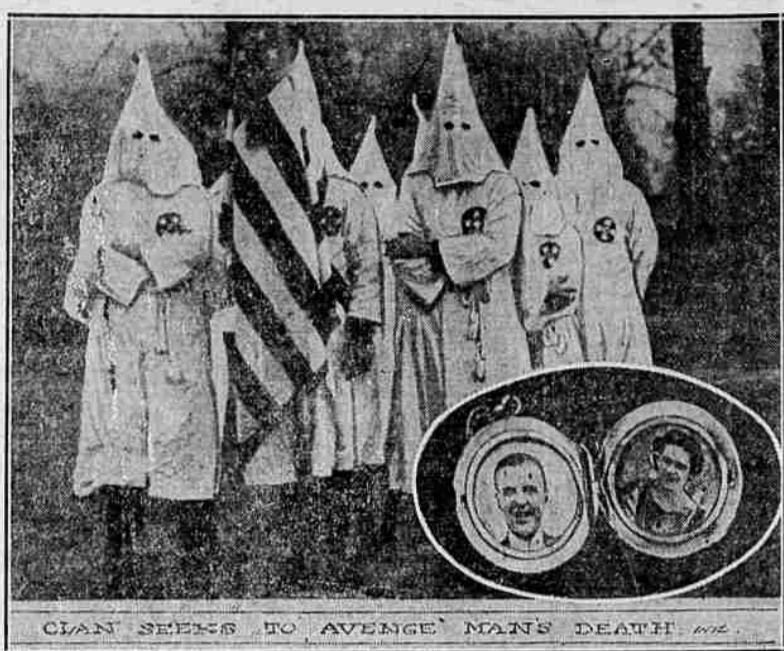
In the line, Herrman will play at one end, the other being selected from Robertson and Winslow. Robertson decided to come out for football a few days ago, having waited all season. He played end last year. Stolzheim and Rhodes will hold down the two positions at tackle. Huston will play center. Guards will be selected from Woodworth, Mort and Evans.

In the final play of a stiff scrimmage Wednesday night, the final hard workout before the Pacific game, Rhodes and Woodworth were both hurt. Woodworth is reported to have had several teeth knocked out. Collingsworth is definitely out of the game with an injured arm. Otherwise the Bearcat squad is practically intact.

The two Emerson brothers, playing in the backfield, are expected to be the mainstay of the Pacific offense. Renown, captain and tackle, is among the strongest men on the defense that Pacific will bring to Salem.

The dope apparently favors Pacific to win Saturday's clash. The Badgers defeated C. P. S. 25 to 6, C. P. S. winning over Willamette 7 to 6. Pacific defeated Linfield 6 to 0, Linfield running away with the long end of a 3 to 0 score against the Bearcats. O. A. C. defeated Pacific 56 to 0, and won over Willamette by a 51 to 0 count. Pacific lost 16 to 7 to the snow carrying passengers.

The company bus which was broken down on the Bend side of the pass has been repaired and taken back to Bend, according to word here.

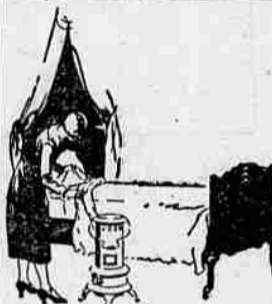
The new snow motor, contrary to general belief, will not open the pass for cars, even though successful, but will itself go over the snow carrying passengers.

La Grande, Or., Nov. 20.—J. A. Rumble, 84, Wallowa county pioneer and veteran of the Civil war, died at his home at Joseph, Or., Tuesday. He was born in Washington county, Iowa, in 1842, and came to Joseph in 1880. He was appointed United States commissioner in 1895. He served on a commission which separated Wallowa county from Union county. He also served as postmaster at Joseph and as councilman. During the Civil war he was a member of the Fourth Iowa cavalry, company D. He enlisted in 1861.

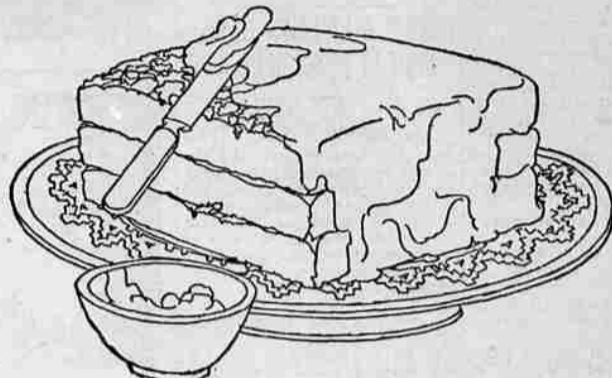

### LIGHTNING CAKE

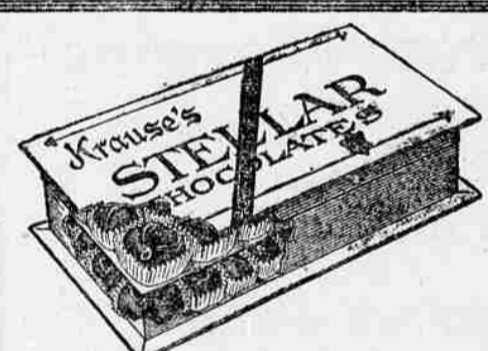
Using Snowdrift in your own favorite recipes is the best way to find out what a really good shortening Snowdrift is. Or, if you like new things try Kate Brew Vaughn's recipe for Lightning Cake.

- 2 cups flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 2 teaspoons mixed spices
- 1 cup sugar
- 3/4 cup Snowdrift (slightly softened)
- 3/4 cup sour milk
- 2 whole eggs
- 1 teaspoon soda
- 1 tablespoon boiling water

Sift together the flour, salt, baking powder, spices and sugar in a large mixing bowl. Combine Snowdrift, milk, and eggs in a small mixing bowl and beat well. Combine two mixtures. Dissolve soda in boiling water and beat well in batter. Pour into greased and floured square cake pans. Bake for 30 minutes in oven at 400 degrees F. Turn out on cake rack to cool and cover with confectioner's icing (1 cup powdered sugar, with enough boiling water to make a paste, and flavor to taste). 1 cup raisins and 3/4 cup nuts may be added to this batter if desired. At 4,000 feet (or over) altitude reduce the sugar to 3/4 cup and the baking powder to one teaspoon.
