

# A HUGE SUCCESS BY HUNDREDS OF SALEM WOMEN

## CRANBERRY BOG IN CHURCH YARD HAS RECORD CROP

Carver, Miss., Nov. 25.—(A. P.)—"Since from God's cranberry bog," the bit of land dedicated here last spring to the support of the little white church at the wayside, will add spice this year to thousands of dinners from that of President Coolidge to that of a Cape Cod missionary in India.

Rev. Charles W. Hidden, leader of the congregation, announced the receipt yesterday of an acknowledgment from the president's secretary which read:

"It was indeed kind of you to send to the president the cranberries which carry with them such interesting associations, and the president has asked me to express to you his thanks for them."

Mrs. Annie Shertoff Boardway, a parishioner whose bog holdings are large, last spring gave a small area for the experiment of the church. Prayers for the success of the venture were said when frosts or other dangers threatened. The bog yielded 100 per cent more berries than in any of the past 30 years.

## CHANGE IN FOOTBALL SCORE COSTS THOUSANDS

San Francisco, Cal., Nov. 25.—The official score of the Stanford-California game, 27 to 14, announced by Referee George M. Varnell many hours after the game was ended and all bets had been paid on an apparently official score of 26 to 14, resulted in the loss of thousands of dollars to bettors in this region. The official score became public for the first time while Varnell was enroute home from Stanford to Seattle.

As a result many winners who should be losers, and winners for all bets have been paid and the winners are not easily identified.

The betting chiefly affected by Varnell's decision was made under the pool system.

## SNOW MOTOR CROSSES PASS

Eugene, Or., Nov. 25.—After some difficulty during the past two weeks, due to mechanical problems, the new snow motor operated by the Eugene-Bend stage line proved its worth Monday and negotiated the McKenzie pass, according to reports brought back here.

The snow tractor climbed the snowbanks with ease and the prospects of all-winter stage service between here and Bend brightened as the snow covered pass was conquered.

### MISCELLANEOUS RECIPES

**Roast Chicken**

1 roasting chicken (weighing from 3 to 5 pounds, dressed)

**Stuffing**

Salt and pepper

Savory oil or fat

After fowl has been washed, drawn and singed, rub with salt and pepper inside and stuff. A stuffing made with chestnuts and celery is very tasty. Truss and tie the fowl, oil and place in an oven preheated to 450 degrees F., and sear quickly. At first placing in the oven, have the back toward the front of the oven to prevent the breast burning, then turn the fowl over and lower the heat at the same time. Reduce the temperature to 350 degrees F., and bake until the breast is tender. Allow about 20 minutes per pound of meat. Weigh meat before stuffing to know how long to bake.

## RUSSIA REFUSES TO JOIN LEAGUE

Moscow, Nov. 25.—(A. P.)—Soviet Russia firmly intends in the future, as in the past, to stand aloof from the league of nations and similar organizations, Acting Foreign Minister Litvinoff declared in a carefully prepared official statement. The Locarno security treaties will not alter the soviet foreign policy, he said.

An electric railway is planned across the Andes mountains between Argentina and Chile. American, British, Swiss and Belgian interests will supply the equipment. The total cost is estimated at \$3,000,000.

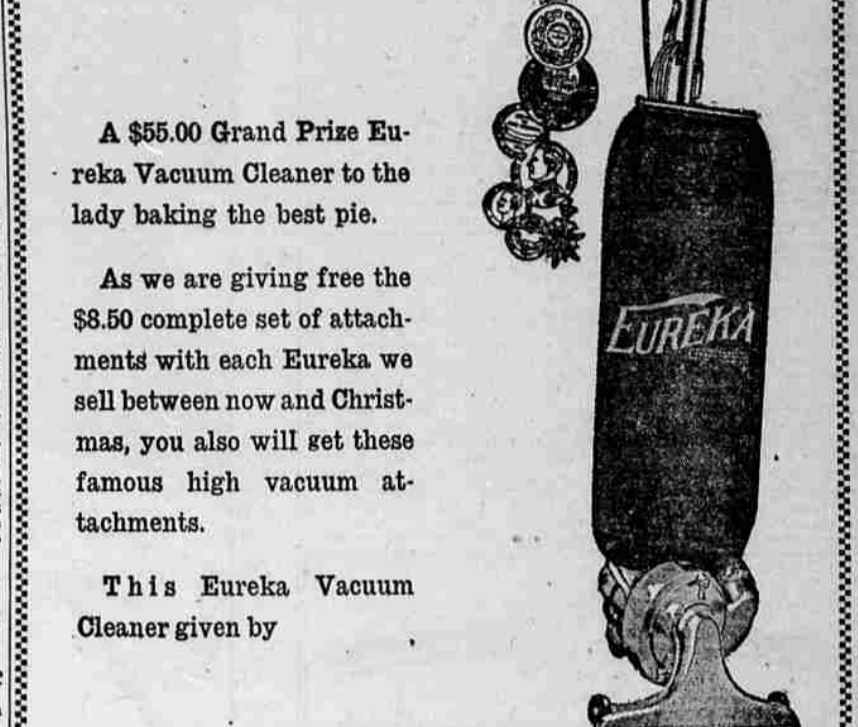

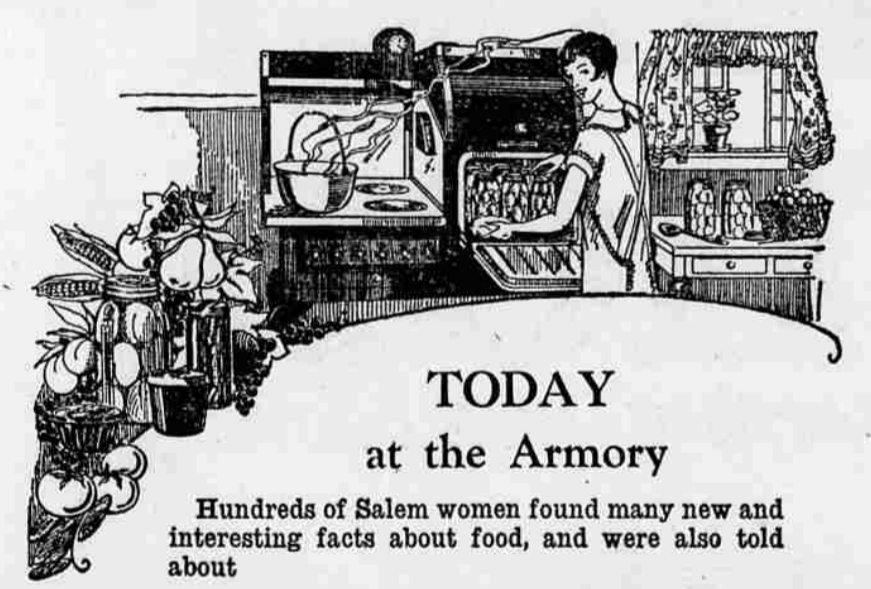
