

### PERSHING SAYS SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTE SLOW

Arica, Nov. 26.—(A.P.)—General John J. Pershing, head of the Tacana-Arica plebiscitary commission said today that despite grave differences in the attitudes and opinions of the Chilean and Peruvian representatives, hope was still entertained that discussion would lead to a solution of the controversy and enable a continuance of the plebiscite commission's labors.

One of the highest of the Chilean plebiscitary officials said he could see no solution, and he authorized a statement that the outlook was hopeless unless the Americans granted the demands in Augustin Evarad's note notifying the plebiscite commission would be notified of the withdrawal of the Chilean delegation. 


