

PA FERGUSON IS REAL GOVERNOR REPORTERS FIND

Austin, Texas, Nov. 30.—(A.P.)—The question of who is the governor of Texas and why, has been given a thorough airing in statements cropping out in the general upheaval centering about demand for the special session of the legislature.

Speaker of the House Lee Satterwhite declared yesterday to Texas newspapermen that Governor Myrlam A. Ferguson, in her executive act, proceeds at the behest of her husband and adviser, former Governor James E. Ferguson.

Correspondents of New York papers, however, got a closer glimpse on the question, after they had, they said, "traveled 2000 miles for the interview" and then had to wait until nearly mid-afternoon for a reception at the executive office. The Texas reporters were barred and told that the governor had nothing to say.

Special dispatches to the New York Times last night said their correspondent learned that James E. Ferguson, who received them, is the "real governor" of Texas. The dispatches say the former governor, whose administration ended in impeachment "factually admitted" that he is the ruling power.

Over On My Island Not the least interesting of birds is the jack snipe. Coming out of a willow thicket suddenly, I quite surprised a fluffy little mother bird and her brood. But while I stood stock still to see what should be done, she fluttered off up the gravel bed as though severely wounded, and she sought by every wile to make me follow. I did not follow her, but from the tail and corner of my eye observed the tiny snipelets scuttling into the covert. The fond mamma, all the time that she was seeking to hold my attention, was issuing orders to the nubile fledglings, when they were safely hidden and all was still, mother snipe quitted the gravelly shore, and flew to a snag over the water. From this vantage point she watched composedly while I took my departure.

Historic Adventures Bonnevillite and the Forest Fire: Probably no greater obstacle ever beset the way of western explorer than the terrific forest and grass fire which raged about the path of Captain Bonnevillite when in 1834 he with a small party of men attempted to descend the Columbia river. Bonnevillite was a United States army officer, who in 1832 secured a leave of absence in order to explore the great West and find some way of re-establishing American trade in the vast district which had been pioneered by John Jacob Astor's furtraders. He had suffered almost unbelievable hardships in making a winter trip thru the mountains to Fort Walla Walla, arriving there in March, 1834. But the Hudson's Bay were not in the humor to lend or sell him supplies, and he returned speedily to his rendezvous in the mountains, only to sail forth again in July, determined to go down the Columbia whether helped by the British concern or not.

But fate seemed to conspire against Bonnevillite. Upon reaching the Grande Ronde valley, he and his men found that the Indians had set fire to the prairies, and that the whole district was a veritable fiery furnace. Food supplies were getting low and the year was waning, so Bonnevillite's men pressed forward through the smoke and flame to Fort Walla Walla. Here they were again rebuffed. No food supplies were to be purchased and the Hudson's Bay would lend no encouragement to the American invaders.

Pass Sought For. Captain Bonnevillite, knew, believing that he knew that there are passages through the mountains to the west of him which would lead by an easy route into the Willamette valley. He accordingly sent scouts to seek for a pass that might be found in the exigency. But his men found that the fire which had so hotly swept over the prairies, was not raging in the woods and deep timber. After a heroic but futile effort at finding a way, these early-day would-be path-finders gave over the attempt, and returned to Bonnevillite's main party. The wonder is that they survived the ordeal and were able to locate and join their leader. After this, the whole party, half-famished and discouraged, hurried eastward to their mountain rendezvous, thus ending Bonnevillite's explorative journey in the Oregon Country.
