

HIGH BUTTER PRICES OVER FOR PRESENT TIME

Portland, Ore., Dec. 5.—(A.P.)—Indications in the local butter market at the end of the week are that high prices are over for the time being with the future trend of the market downward.

During the closing season of the exchange cube butter cases off half to 1 cent throughout the entire list. Standards are a half cent lower at 50 cents while all other grades are one cent lower.

Prints closed at the 55 cent level for parchment wrapped, with cartons at 56 cents. Buying price of butterfat is still 53 cents f. o. b. shippers track.
