

SOURCE AND USES OF GOVERNMENT FINANCES TOLD

Washington, Dec. 8.—(A. P.)—The story of where the government's money comes from and where it goes, in terms of the average dollar, was told today in estimates for 1927 submitted by the budget bureau as follows:

Where it comes from—Income and profit tax, 49.16 cents; miscellaneous internal revenue, 22.85 cents; customs revenue, 14.33 cents; interest, premium and discount, 4.95 cents; fees, fines, penalties and forfeitures, .84 cent; repayments on investments, 1.62 cents; trust fund receipts, 2.16 cents; other miscellaneous receipts, 3.99 cents.

Where it goes—General functions of government, 3.55 cents; national defense, 16.32 cents; military pensions, retirement pay, annuities, World War allowances and life insurance claims, 18.55 cents; public works, 5.59 cents; promotion, regulation and operation of marine transportation, 1.85 cents; other civil functions, 7.49 cents; refunds, 4.91 cents; public debt retirement for ordinary receipts, 14.76 cents; interest on public debt, 22.75 cents; trust funds, 6.48 cents.

Who spends it—Legislative establishment, .46 cent; executive office, .91 cent; veterans bureau, 10.52 cents; other independent establishments, 1.61 cents; agriculture, 4.33 cents; commerce, .86 cent; interior, 7.56 cents; justice (including judicial), .70 cent; labor, .25 cent; navy, 9.55 cents; deficiency in postal revenue, .71 cent; state, .47 cent; treasury, 8.78 cents public debt retirement, 14.76 cents; interest on public

debt, 22.75 cents; investment of trust funds, 5.60 cents; war, including Panama canal, 9.94 cents; District of Columbia, 1.4 cents.

EGAN ESTATE VALUED AT \$41,556, MOSTLY FARMS

The estate of the late William H. Egan is valued at \$41,556, according to a report filed in probate by David Keene, Homer Gouley and Frank Lick, appraisers. The larger bulk of the estate is made up of real property in the northern part of Marion county, considerable of it high class farm land, including one of the famous peach orchards of this section.

The land in this county is valued at \$37,500, and includes one tract of 182 acres, another of 250.25 acres and another of 67.74 acres. Land in Yamhill county is valued at \$2,599 and includes 100 acres, cut up into three parcels. Other real property is a lot in Riverside addition to Salem. Personal property is valued at about \$1,500.
