

THEOSOPHISTS JOURNEYING TO SECOND COMING

New York, Dec. 14.—Thousands of Theosophists are journeying to India in anticipation of the "second coming of Christ," the New York Tribune says today.

They are drawn by the prophecy of their leader, Mrs. Annie Besant, International president of the Theosophical society, that within the next five months the star of Bethlehem will burn over Adjar, India, and Christ will return to the earth in the body of Krishnamurti, a 30 year old Hindu.

The anticipated appearance of the "new Christ" which has been kept secret for some time was revealed by Captain R. L. Jones book shop proprietor and American representative of Mrs. Besant. Only a few weeks ago the young Hindu upon whom godhood is to descend, quietly visited this country, meeting members of the faith.

"Christ will simply come as before, this time using the body of Krishnamurti as his vehicle," Captain Jones explained.

But there will be no angelic trumpet and no clouds of glory. The event will have a modern aspect. Seven persons are being prepared as apostles and the other five will be appointed in India. Modern publicity agents will herald the arrival of the "new Christ" as he and his apostles journey through the world proclaiming his message to humanity.

Although Besant has set five months from now as the time for the event, other Theosophists have set it as early as Christmas.

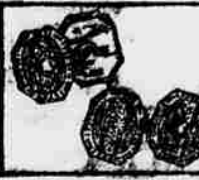
