

### DOUMER BEGINS WORK TO SALVAGE FRENCH FINANCE

Paris, Dec. 18.—(A. P.)—Paul Doumer, the new minister of finance, has been duly installed in office and has begun his work to aid France in making its way out of the financial slough.

His first care will be to accelerate the voting of the budget by parliament. He will leave other financial problems to be dealt with later in their proper order. The original plans of M. Doumer, it is understood, will be modified in the light of various votes in the chamber, since he first prepared them three weeks ago. He is convinced that nothing can be gained by precipitate action. Therefore, he will give the cabinet, at a meeting on Saturday, a general outline of his financial program and will submit the bills based on it to the chamber of deputies after the New Year's recess.

One thing, however, has been decided upon. M. Doumer's program will have the seal of approval of the entire government before it is published. It therefore will not be the finance minister's plan, but the government's plan, and its rejection will entail the resignation of the Briand government.

### MAYOR LUTHER I. POWELL REMAINS IN VANCOUVER

Vancouver, B. C., Dec. 18.—(A. P.)—Mayor Luther I. Powell of Portland, organizer of the Kanadian Ku Klux Klan, will be permitted to remain in Vancouver pending outcome of his appeal to Ottawa against a ruling refusing him permission to remain permanently in Canada, immigration authorities announced yesterday. Powell was barred from entering Canada but was given a 30 day permit which expired today.
