

### OREGON PRIMED TO GIVE BATTLE TO CARDINALS

Oregon football fans, after a week of rest, will turn towards Eugene Saturday to see the fighting Websters and Stanford mix in the Oregon homecoming contest, and the first conference mix for the Cardinals. Saturday's game will bring to a close one of the most historic events of the University of Oregon, the semi-centennial celebration and the inauguration of a new president.

Coch J. J. McEwan, who watched Stanford play Nevada last Saturday, returned to Eugene with a whole note book full of Cardinal strong and weak points and has been drilling his men to take advantage of all of these. With two weeks' practice since the Washington game at Portland, the Oregonians will very likely appear more polished, due to intensive drill of defensive tactics. The former army mentor had little time to devote to this department of the game in preparing for the clash with Washington.

Oregon is expected to improve as the season ends, as it did last year against the Huskies at Seattle. The Lemon-Yellow squad has a speedy, deceptive offense that is to be feared, as shown in the first half of the game with the 1925 champions.

Stanford's ability is an unknown quantity. Before training season opened the Warner players were doped to be strong, but the showing made in non-conference tilts has caused a drop in the stock market. Last week a speedy Nevada team, not up to the calibre of conference teams, walked off the field with a 9 to 0 lead at the end of the first half. However, Stanford uncorked an offensive that smothered the Nevadans under a 33 to 9 defeat, and the Cardinals were again favored to make the running close.

The annual tilt to decide the championship of the state of Washington will be played when the Huskies meet Washington

State. The Staters, under the tutelage of "Babe" Hollinsberry, have shown that they will be no set up. The Purple Tornado is favored to win, however.

The California Bears will not have much chance against the University of Southern California at Berkeley Saturday, if it thought. The Aggies and Idaho will have a chance to rest prior to their meeting in Portland on October 30. No other conference games are scheduled for the week-end.

Montana will play Montana State at Butte, and for the first time in several years the Grizzlies will be the underdogs.

### NO PREVENTATIVE HEADS OFF COLD

Stanford University, Cal., Oct. 21.—(AP)—Dr. William Barrow, medical adviser to men at Stanford university, revealed today the result of a survey he has made respecting the causes of colds which runs counter to many of the established notions regarding those universal afflictions.

"You can sleep in the open air, change from a hot to a cold climate, take a cold bath every morning and refuse to heat your house; or you can keep your bedroom air-tight, take hot baths and wear your rubbers when it rains and it will not lessen or increase your chances of catching a cold," says the medical adviser.

The only precaution one can take, Dr. Barrow says, is to belong to the feminine gender, for women are less susceptible to colds than men.

The report is based on questionnaires sent to 2500 students. The result coincides with the outcome of a survey made at Cornell university in 1924 by Dr. D. P. Smiley. It all depends, both discovered, on one's individual constitution.

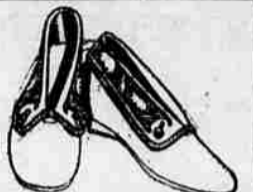
