

For Her Who Would A Sporting Go



Whether you "go in for sports" or not, it matters little as far as sports clothes are concerned. For the world of sports clothes is a wide and varied one and no one nowadays would think of not including a few sports dresses and sports outfits in her wardrobe any time of the year.

So important has been the influence of sports on the mode that we see its reaction even in clothes for evening.

Compose Themes Stressed
In all the new sports things for spring we see a decided use of compose themes—which are nothing else but the use of two and three shades of one color in a frock or a costume.

Black and white is a great favorite and shades of rose and beige are much in prominence as "the" colors for spring. Often one sees a blouse or a jacket of one shade and the skirt of a darker tone or vice versa. But always the compose theme is evident.

Materiale Important
Jersey—the old reliable—is again seen in many of the smartest sports modes. Other materials include knitted construction, wool crepe, crepe de chine, silk faille and many others.

Despite all sorts of predictions—pen and con—the two-piece frock still holds first place in all sportswear outfits. There is no denying the freedom of the two-piece frock and often this spring we see three-piece ensembles, consisting of a two-piece dress and a short jacket for the more active sports or the more formal full length coat for the woman who would rather be numbered among the spectators than the participants.

All the stores and shops are showing lovely things in fabric combinations such as kasha with flat crepe or knitted fabric, sometimes made more fascinating by the use of clever woven metal thread.

Coat Still Important
Women everywhere are happy to know that in that matter of sports ensembles, the coat retains all of its former importance. On all the smart links and country club verandas this spring we'll see clever variations of the four-piece suit—skirt, blouse, sleeveless bolero and full length coat.

Everywhere the importance of the cardigan (meaning a jacket of knitted fabric with or without sleeves) is noted. The cardigan is often of cashmere and the skirt of homespun. There is something very stunning as you well know, about black and white together and this combination is seen in all sorts of ways on many of the smartest spring sports ensembles and frocks.

Silk Weaves Showed
Silk weaves in lovely colors often "make" a frock especially where the compose theme is used. In our "Spring Fashion Hunt," we saw one lovely little two-piece frock of green blue flat crepe with a double decorative effect on the skirt in sunburst pleats of darker tone.

Some of the smartest conceptions of the sports mode are the little one-piece sleeveless affairs with fancy pleated skirts and becoming square or V neck. Mostly these are in attractive printed tub silks in checked or floral designs or in plain white or colors.

Sleeveless are also prominently shown in most of the little jackets either bolero or otherwise that are one of the newest notes for spring. We might even call them vests. They are stunning in bright shades

of selection for wear with crepe or jersey sports ensembles.

Sportswear More Gay
We note, too, that clothes for wear at sport or otherwise are more frivolous, more gay—often we see draping trails and the ash. Handkerchief trimming for the neck is much in vogue again.

They by day in every way pleasing is gaining in favor for dresses of every type—but never do we see it used to more charming advantage than in the newest spring sports frocks.

Both fine and wide pleating—but always there must be pleating in the skirt; sleeves are set-in, yoked or saddle shoulder treatments. Deep yoke effects, bolero and bloused bodices, sailor collars and bow tying yokes, collars and belts are noteworthy details of the sports dresses.

Chaperons Back To Help Girls Marry

London, Mar. 20.—(AP)—The chaperon, so whole heartedly abolished in the years during and after the war, has come back to fashionable London and is more in evidence at dances and other public functions than at any time since Victorian days.

One reason for this, according to society gossip, is that young unchaperoned girls, while having a generally good time, have not made good marriages or have remained single, while the girls more carefully brought up and chaperoned have secured the best plans in the marriage market.

It is seldom now that society girls go to a ball or dinner without their mothers or some woman relative while many society dames with moderate incomes are in great demand as paid chaperons.

Men Legal Arbiters On Dress In France

Paris, Mar. 21.—(AP)—Men are the legal arbiters on dress in France. In a lawsuit over a woman's gown, it is a man and not a woman, who is called to give testimony or make an appraisal.

The courts have experts in every line of business attached to them. They usually are men of prominence in their trade. There are 12 qualified to advise the judges regarding dresses. All are men.

Several judges have suggested women should be included among these experts and probably some of them will be nominated before long, although now, as ever, men continue to dominate the dress-making industry or art of France.

Hotel Chefs Devise Hot Hors D'Oeuvre

London, Mar. 21.—(AP)—A new delicacy, or series of delicacies—the hot hors d'oeuvre—have been introduced to London. Fourteen chefs at a leading hotel have each evolved six hot hors d'oeuvre dishes. In the preparation of these dishes 224 ingredients have been used, including fish, birds, eggs, vegetables, and strange fruit from all over Europe and Northern Africa.

The dishes are served in the hotel gardens and the inventor of those that prove to be most popular will receive a handsome reward.
