The third man to be recaptured was caught by the bloodhounds in a confield near the prisen farm where he was hiding.

The three guards that were forced to accompany the men were taken about 10 or 15 miles from the farm and one of them was forced to change clothes with a convict. The guards later made their way back to the prison farm.
