"In construing the statute we look to what the legislature had in mind to accomplish. Clearly there was no intention to create additional funds. The allocation of the funds was the problem which the legislature undertook to and did solve. The provisions of the prior statutes have been reenacted in the amendatory act and, in addition thereto, there have been incorporated certain sections pertaining to the control and management of institutions of higher education, all of which are germane to the title of the amendatory act could have been misled as to its subject matter. The words 'to provide for the " " support " c' the state institutions of higher education' are sufficiently broad and comprehensive for the re-enactment of the tax levies in question.
